Each candidate will get to know his date of Personality Test through the link (wbprb.applythrunet.co.in) provided in the website on keying of their Application Sl. No. and Date of Birth in the fields provide for that. However, a candidate will be able to download their e-call letters for the Personality Test only 07(seven) days before his date of Personality Test only after filling up the CoVID Declaration Form truthfully as a precautionary measure to prevent the spread of the disease. The candidates shall have to produce the printout of their e-call letters together with filled up CoVID Declaration Form before the Testimonial Checking Desk of the Range Recruitment Board concerned at the time of reporting on the date of their Personality Test. The e-call letters for personality test will be uploaded on the website (wbpolice.gov.in) on 15.02.2021. The Board will send SMS alert intimating the date and venue of Personality Test to the shortlisted candidates to their registered mobile numbers. However the Board will not be held responsible for non-delivery of such SMS due to change in mobile number and/or technical reasons. Call letters will be made available in no other mode.

Candidates are directed to carry identical photographs along with proof of identity and other documents as mentioned in the e-call letters for Personality Test. The candidates are also advised to follow the instructions on their e-call letter and visit the website of West Bengal Police regularly for further updates.

Wearing of 3 ply face mask is mandatory. No candidate shall be allowed to take part in the Personality Test without wearing a fresh 3 ply mask and no further date of Personality Test shall be fixed for such candidates. They are advised to report at the venue at the time mentioned in their e-call letters. Candidates are advised to report to the venue in the sessions mentioned in their e-call letter and will not be entertained in another session. Candidate's body temperature & SpO₂ will be measured on his arrival at the entrance of the venue. Candidates with body temperature & SpO₂ which is beyond / below the normal reference level shall not be allowed to take part in the Personality Test.
