**ADVERTISEMENT NOTICE No. Pers-Rectt-A-22/2019/2474-99**

**Dated // -01-2022**

In continuation to earlier advertisement notice issued under endorsement No. Pers-Rectt-A-22-2019/16251-300 dated 09-03-2019 for the post of Constable in two Women Battalions (one Battalion each in Jammu/Kashmir Region) and in pursuance to Government of Jammu and Kashmir Home Department letter No. Home-PNG/201/2021-01-(CC-45001) dated 17-12-2021, wherein the competent authority has approved for issuance of fresh advertisement notification excluding UT of Ladakh so as to give opportunity to eligible candidates who are domicile of Jammu and Kashmir to apply and participate in the selection process and be considered as per existing rules.

Police Recruitment Board invites online applications from eligible (Female candidates only), Domicile of UT J&K for participation in the selection process for the post of Constable in two Women Battalions of the Jammu and Kashmir Police, as per guidelines conveyed by MHA GOI vide letter No. 13030/50/2015.K.II (pt) dated 13-06-2018, wherein 60% posts will be kept reserved for women of border districts of Jammu region and will be equally divided among border districts. Remaining 40% of posts will be equally distributed for rest of the districts of Jammu region. Similarly, in Kashmir region 60% of posts shall be kept reserved for women of Border districts and will be equally divided among border districts of Kashmir. Remaining 40% of posts will be equally distributed in rest of the districts of Kashmir region in the Pay Band-I of Rs.5200-20200 + Grade pay 1900/- (Now revised 19900-63200 Level-2).

*The candidates who had earlier qualified PET/PST for the post of Constable in two Women Battalions in response to PHQ Advertisement Notice issued under endorsement No. Pers-Rectt-A-22-2019/16251-300 dated 09-03-2019 need not apply again as they are eligible for the written examination.*

*Similarly the candidates who were disqualified in PET/PST under the above quoted advertisement can not apply again as their applications would not be considered.*

**2)- Reservation:**

Reservation for Scheduled Castes (SC), Scheduled Tribes(ST), Economically Weaker Section(EWS), Pahari Speaking People(PSP), Social Caste(OSC), Residents Backward Area(RBA), Line of Actual Control(ALC)/International Border(IB) for the above posts, wherever applicable and admissible, would be as determined, in accordance with the provisions of SRO 294 dated 21-10-2005 and S.O 127 dated 20-04-2020.

A candidate seeking her consideration under Reserved Categories must ensure that she possess a valid/ Category Certificate as on the Cut-off Date of filling of application form. The certificate will have to be produced in accordance with timeline setup by the Board.

The candidates who had earlier qualified PET/PST under above quoted advertisement and possess any category certificate in pursuance to S.O 127 of 2020 dated 20-04-2020 can submit their requisite certificate issued by the competent authority to be considered against such reserved category.

**3)- Domicile: -**

The candidate should be a Domicile of the Union Territory of Jammu & Kashmir as defined in terms of the Notifications issued by the Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India vide S.O 1229 (E) dated 31-03-2020 and S.O 1245(E) dated 03-04-2020 read with notification issued by the General Administration Department, Government of Jammu and Kashmir vide S.O 166 dated 18-05-2020.

The candidate must possess Domicile Certificate issued by the Competent Authority on the format prescribed for the purpose, before the last date of submission of online application form.

**4)- I** The educational qualification, age and physical standards prescribed for the abovementioned posts are specified as under:-

i)	Educational Qualification	The Candidate should have passed matriculation examination from any Government recognized Board by or before the last date for submission of application form.
ii)	Age (as on January, 1 <sup>st</sup> , 2022)	<p>a. The candidates should not be below 18 years and above 28 years in age.  <b>(The candidates born before 01.01.1994 and after 31.12.2003 shall not be eligible.)</b></p> <p>b. The candidates who were below 28 years of age at the time of issuance of earlier advertisement notification but could not apply being non permanent residents and have now acquired eligibility in view of being domicile of UT J&amp;K and have crossed upper age limit shall also be eligible.</p> <p>c. However, in case of serving SPOs with a continuous period of engagement of minimum three years and Voluntary Home Guards (VHG) with a period of engagement of minimum five years, the upper age limit shall be 37 years and for Ex-Servicemen it shall be 48 years.</p> <p>d. The SPOs/VHGs and Ex-servicemen who were below 37 years and 48 years of age at the time of issuance of earlier advertisement notification but could not apply being non permanent residents and have now acquired eligibility in view of being domicile of UT J&amp;K and have crossed upper age limit shall also be eligible.</p>
iii)	Physical Standards	<p>Height = 5 feet -2 inch (minimum.)</p> <p><b>For candidates belonging to Gorkha community (Domicile of UT J&amp;K )</b></p> <p>Height = 5 feet (minimum.)</p>

III) The candidates possessing basic eligibility criteria viz age and educational qualification as prescribed here in above shall be subject to the following tests:-

A.	Physical Endurance Test(PET)- Qualifying in nature (only candidates who qualify the Physical Endurance Test (PET) shall be eligible for the PST)	Long Race = 1000 meters in 6½ minutes (six minutes thirty seconds). Shot Put (4Kgs) = 14½ feet in three attempts • The test shall be of qualifying nature for which no marks will be allotted.
B.	Special provision regarding relaxation in Physical Endurance Tests for Ex-Serviceman in accordance with S.O 361 of 2021 dated 20-10-2021.	<b>(Age-Upto 30 years)</b> Long Race 1000 meters -6 ½ Minutes (Six minutes thirty seconds ) Shot Put (4 kgs)- 14 ½ Feet in three attempts. <b>(Age-Above 30 to 40 years)</b> Long Race 1000 Metres-7½ Minutes (Seven minutes thirty seconds) Shot Put (4 kgs) 12 ½ Feet in three attempts. <b>(Age-Above 40 years)</b> Race 1000 Metres-8 ½ minutes (Eight minutes thirty seconds ) Shot Put (4 kgs) 10 ½ Feet in three attempts.
C.	Physical Standard Test (PST)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Measurement of Height</li> </ul> The candidates are also required to bring alongwith their original documents/testimonials for scrutiny during the PST.
D.	Written Examination (Objective type) Only for the candidates who qualify PET/PST shall be allowed to sit in written test.	The written test will consist of objective questions. The question paper will consist of 100 questions to be attempted in 2 hours. The question paper will be of matriculation standard will comprise questions on general awareness/general knowledge, elementary mathematics, analytical aptitude and ability.

5)- Since the 60% posts are to be equally distributed in Border Districts and 40% posts are to be equally distributed in remaining Districts, candidates belonging to the domicile District cannot apply for appointment in other District except SC category, who can apply only in any one District of her own choice of the UT of J&K. In case a candidate applies for appointment in more than one District, her application will be summarily rejected without any notice to the candidate.

6)- The instruction for filling up of online application form is enclosed as annexure "A". Candidate shall deposit a fee of Rs. 300/- (Rupees Three hundred only) online or use the services of Common Service Centers. In case of non availability of online payment facility, the candidates may use the option of depositing the application fee through Bank Challan. Candidates are requested to read and follow these instructions carefully as no amount once deposited will ever be refunded for reasons whatsoever.

7)- Candidates already in Government service and conforming to the prescribed standards can apply through proper channel after obtaining NOC from their Head of the Department without which the online applications will not be entertained.

8)- The recruitment will be undertaken under Transparent Recruitment Process (TRP) through an Outsourcing firm.

9)- **Last date for submission of online application form shall be 30 days after the activation of the link which will be notified separately.** The last date for the receipt of the application provided in the notification shall be the cutoff date for determining the eligibility with regard to educational qualification/relevant category. Any qualification or claim accruing to the candidate after last date of receipt of application shall not be entertained. The selection of the candidates for the post of Constable shall be made at District level on their performance in written test vis-à-vis number of vacancies. In case of tie in merit, the preference will be given to the candidate older in age. **In terms of S.O 290 of 2021 dated 20-08-2021 the candidates possessing National Cadet Corps (NCC) Certificates shall be awarded bonus marks as per the said SO. However, those candidates who had qualified PET/PST possesses NCC certificate can submit valid NCC certificate issued before cut-off date of earlier advertisement notification.**

10)- Since, the recruitment is being made for raising 02 Women Battalions on the strength of J&K Police, as such, the appointees will have to render their services wherever required in the UT of J&K.

11)- In terms of the directions issued by the State Government vide No. Home/PB-III/62/G/2008 dated 25-09-2009, the horizontal reservation to the extent of 15% and 4% shall be given to eligible serving SPOs and VHGs respectively (provided SPOs have completed continuous engagement of 03 years and VHGs have completed 05 years of service on the last date of submission of online application). Besides, horizontal reservation to the extent of 6% shall be given to eligible Ex-Servicemen.

12)- The candidate working as SPOs/Volunteer Home Guard and conforming to the eligibility as envisaged in para 4-I(ii) of the notice shall attach certificate(s) relating to their engagement as SPO/Volunteer Home Guards issued by the concerned DDO/SSP under his seal/signatures with date of issue. No such certificate will be entertained after the last date of submission of online application.


13)- The fixation of pay of the appointees shall be regulated as per the provisions of SO 192 of 2020 dated 17-06-2020.

14)- Upon their appointment, candidates who have obtained any loan/stipend under the self employment scheme or any other category will be allowed to join only in case they obtain a clearance certificate from the concerned department/bank to the effect they have refunded the loan/cleared the liability.

15)- The candidates shall have to appear in the prescribed tests at their own expenses on the date and venue to be communicated by the Police Recruitment Board, through press or electronic media.

16)- In case, it is found at any stage of recruitment that the candidate was not eligible for the post or has given wrong information, her candidature shall be summarily rejected without any further notice to her and the same may attract legal action.


17)- The selected candidates shall be subjected to prescribed medical examination /checkup through Standing Medical Boards and the appointment orders shall be issued only after receipt of satisfactory medical report and clearance about her character/antecedents from CID. The selected candidates shall be required to undergo the prescribed Basic Training Course.
