## Gol Appoints Four Supreme Court Judges

- The Centre has cleared four names recommended by the Supreme Court Collegium for elevation as judges of the apex court. The four appointed judges are
  - 1. Himachal Pradesh High Court: Chief Justice V. Ramasubramanian
  - 2. Punjab and Haryana High Court: Chief Justice Krishna Murari
  - 3. Rajasthan High Court: Chief Justice S. Ravindra Bhat
  - 4. Kerala High Court: Chief Justice Hrishikesh Roy
- The Supreme Court vacancies had increased its judicial strength from 31 to 34 following the enactment of the Supreme Court (Number of Judges) Bill of 2019.

- Jal Shakti Minister and Sports Minister flagged off "Great Ganga Run-2019" at Jawaharlal Nehru Stadium in New Delhi.
- Saint Vincent and Grenadines became the 79th country to join the International Solar Alliance (ISA), an initiative by India aimed at combating the threats of climate change and global warming.
- Union Minister for Communications, Electronics & Information Technology and Law & Justice Ravi Shankar Prasad has launched the Maritime Communication Services at Mumbai, Maharashtra.
- India's first **National Antimicrobial Resistance Hub** was recently inaugurated in **Kolkata**.
- India has formally launched an initiative to fund 1000 scholars from South East Asian countries to pursue PhD at its 23 Indian Institutes of Technology.
- The Public Premises (Eviction of Unauthorized Occupants) Amendment Bill, 2019 has come into effect.
- India has commenced a special training programme for Maldivian and Bangladeshi civil servants at Mussoorie in Uttarakhand.
- 5th International Ramayan Festival organized by Indian Council for Cultural Relations (ICCR), in New Delhi.



- Union Minister of State for Power RK Singh and Jammu and Kashmir Governor Satya Pal Malik have jointly inaugurated 15 power projects.
- The Jal Shakti Ministry is planning to develop a National Water Museum to increase awareness among people on the conservation of the natural resource.
- The Department of India Posts has announced commencing of International Speed Post (EMS) Service to Bosnia and Herzegovina, Brazil, Ecuador, Kazakhstan, Lithuania and North Macedonia.
- Google has announced that it will open an artificial intelligence (AI) based research lab "Google Research India". The lab will be opened in Bengaluru.
- The country's first central police university will be set up by the Union home ministry off the Yamuna Expressway in Greater Noida.
- Human Resource Development Minister Ramesh Pokhriyal 'Nishank' has launched Waste Management Accelerator for Aspiring Women Entrepreneurs (WAWE) summit.
- The Digital Communication Commission, the highest decision making body in the Department of Telecom has approved multiple projects worth over Rs 8,500 crore.
- National Thermal Power Corporation Limited (NTPC) plans to set up a 5-gigawatt solar park in the western state of Gujarat, which would be the biggest in the country.

#### **States in the News**

- Union Minister for Environment and Forest and Information & Broadcasting Prakash Javadekar flagged off a Jaldoot vehicle a travelling exhibition in Pune, Maharashtra. The van carrying the 'SAVE WATER' message will travel to different parts of the state.
- Karnataka Chief Minister B S Yediyurappa announced that the Hyderabad-Karnataka region has been renamed as 'Kalyana Karnataka' and a separate secretariat would be established for its development.



- Arunachal Pradesh Chief Minister Pema Khandu dedicated the Dikshi Hydroelectric Project to the people of the state. The 24 Mega Watt Hydroelectric Project has been installed at Dikshi Village in West Kameng District.
- Delhi Lieutenant Governor Anil Baijal launched 'Tatpar' app, developed by the Delhi Police, which is a one-stop destination for access to over 50 citizen-centric services.
- Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal launched "Champions Campaign" to fight dengue and urged citizens to become 'champions' and encourage 10 friends to check their homes for mosquito larvae.

### **International Affairs**

Sri Lanka unveiled South Asia's tallest tower, costing over \$100 million, 80% of which has been funded by China under the controversial Belt and Road Initiative (BRI). The 350-metre-tall 17-storey Lotus Tower, located in the heart of Colombo city.

- Tata Communications has partnered with Cisco to offer enterprises a secure, fully-managed, multichannel, intelligent and cloud-based Cisco Webex Contact Center solution.
- The Directorate General of Training (DGT), under the skill development and entrepreneurship ministry, has signed an agreement with IT major IBM to carry out a nationwide Train-the-Trainer programme in basic artificial intelligence.
- Nasscom's Data Security Council of India (DSCI) collaborated with the electronics and IT ministry (MeitY) and Google India to launch a nationwide awareness campaign 'Digital Payment Abhiyan'.

- Airtel Payments Bank launched "Bharosa savings **account**" services, designed for deepening the financial inclusion in the country.
- Wipro Consumer Care and Lighting has launched "Wipro Consumer Care-Ventures", a startup venture fund to invest in startups in the consumer brands space.

- Wing Commander Anjali Singh has joined the Indian Embassy in Russia as India's first female military **diplomat** to be posted in any of the Indian missions abroad. She has joined her new assignment as the Deputy Air Attache.
- Asian Development Bank (ADB) President Takehiko Nakao has announced his resignation. He became the president of ADB on April 28, 2013.



- Robert O'Brien has been appointed as the National Security Adviser of United States of America. He will replace John Bolton as the NSA of US.
- The central Government has appointed Vice Chief of the Indian Air Force (IAF) Air Marshal RKS Bhadauria as the next Chief of Air Staff (CAS). He will take over on 30th September. He will have a two-year tenure.
- IDBI Bank's Board of Directors has approved the appointment of Samuel Joseph Jebaraj as Deputy Managing Director (DMD) for a period of 3 years.

#### **Defence News**

- DRDO and the Aeronautical Development Agency successfully executed the first-ever arrested landing of Light Combat Aircraft(LCA) Tejas (Navy) at the shore-based test facility in Goa. This is a step towards the aircraft getting operational on aircraft carrier INS Vikramaditya.
- The White water Rafting Expedition christened 'RUDRASHILA' being undertaken by Kalidhar Battalion under the aegis of Battle Axe Division was Flagged Off at Jaisalmer Military station.
- A maiden trilateral exercise **SITMEX**, involving Republic of Singapore Navy (RSN), Royal Thailand Navy (RTN) and Indian Navy (IN) started at Port Blair.
- Indian Air Force has successfully flight-tested air-to-air missile **Astra** off the coast of Odisha. The missile was launched from a Sukhoi Su-30 MKI combat aircraft.
- Defence Minister Rajnath Singh becomes the first defence minister to fly in the indigenously-built light combat aircraft (LCA) Tejas. He flew in the Tejas fighter aircraft from the HAL airport in Bengaluru.
- The Indian Army conducted a massive rare exercise 'Chang Thang' in Eastern Ladakh bordering China. The exercise involved the use of infantry, mechanised forces, T-72 tanks, with force multipliers such as artillery guns and Unmanned Aerial Vehicles. The Indian Air Force was also roped in the exercise.
