- **Maharashtra and Haryana** Assembly (Vidhan Sabha) Election 2019 Date, Scheduled on 21st October, while counting of votes will be held on October 24.
- Prime Minister Narendra Modi inaugurated a 50 kilowatt 'Gandhi Solar Park' at the UN headquarters. PM Modi and other leaders also released a commemorative postage stamp of Mahatma Gandhi, at the programme "Relevance of Mahatma Gandhi in the Contemporary World" at the UN headquarters.
- **President Ram Nath Kovind** inaugurated the sixth **"India Water Week-2019"** being organised with the theme of "Water cooperation-coping with 21st-century challenge' at Vigyan Bhawan in New Delhi.
- As per the **Indian Meteorological Department**, Earthquake hits the Pakistan-India border region at around 4:31 PM on 24th September 2019. The earthquake was of the magnitude of **6.3** on the Richter scale and a depth of **40 km**.

- **Madhukar Kamath** was elected as the chairman of the Audit Bureau of Circulations (ABC) for 2019-20.
- Pink tickets will be issued to women passengers under the Delhi government's scheme for free travel in DTC and cluster buses which was approved by the Delhi Transport Corporation (DTC) board.
- Jammu and Kashmir has become the first state in the country to issue the highest number of golden cards under Ayushman Bharat-Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (AB-PMJAY).
- Chief Minister of Uttar Pradesh **Yogi Adityanath** announced an annual support of **₹6,000 to the victims of triple talaq.**
- Madhya Pradesh Chief Minister Kamal Nath announced that the metro rail in Bhopal will be named for Raja Bhoj.



- Army officer **Ponung Doming** became the first woman officer from Arunachal Pradesh to be elevated to the rank of Lieutenant Colonel in the Indian Army.
- Defence Minister Rajnath Singh has formally commissioned the Indian Coast Guard offshore patrol vessel 'Varaha' at the Chennai Port Trust.
- The **23rd edition** of the trilateral maritime exercise of India, Japan and the United States (US) named "Malabar 2019" exercise begun at Sasebo, Japan.
- Army chief Gen **Bipin Rawat** will take over as the new Chairman of the Chiefs of Staff Committee.
