





# RBI Enhances Scope Of Non-Resident Rupee Accounts

- The RBI expanded the scope of Special Non-Resident Rupee Accounts (SNRR account) by permitting non-residents to open such accounts for rupee-denominated overseas borrowings, trade credit and trade invoicing for popularising cross-border transactions in the domestic currency.
- Any person resident outside India, having a business interest in India, can open a non-interest bearing **Special Non-Resident Rupee Account (SNRR account)** with a bank for bona fide transactions in rupees. The restriction on the tenure of SNRR account, which is currently 7 years, has also been removed. RBI has also modified norms regarding re-export of unsold rough diamonds from the special notified zone of Customs without **export declaration form (EDF)** formality.

# Amaravati included in India map as the capital of Andhra Pradesh

- The Survey of India, India's central engineering agency in charge of mapping and surveying has released an updated map of India with Amaravati as the capital of Andhra Pradesh (AP). Amaravati had been missing from the previous map released by the Centre On November 2, 2019, which showed Hyderabad as the common capital of Telangana & Andhra Pradesh.
- The state of AP was bifurcated in the year 2014 and while it was initially decided that Hyderabad would serve as the common administrative capital for a period of **10 years**.



# Justice SA Bobde takes oath as 47th Chief Justice of India

- **↓** Justice **Sharad Arvind Bobde** took oath as the **47th Chief Justice of India.**
- President Ram Nath Kovind administered him the oath of office at Rashtrapati Bhavan. Justice Bobde succeeds Justice Ranjan Gogoi, who retired on 17 November.
- Justice Bobde will have a tenure of around 18 months till his retirement on April 23, 2021. Justice Bobde was elevated as a Judge of the Supreme Court on April 12, 2013.
- He was part of the five-judge constitution bench which delivered the landmark Ayodhya verdict.

# Home Ministry launches campaign to End Violence Against Women

- ♣ The Home Ministry in collaboration with the UN Women flagged off an awareness campaign To End Violence Against Women from Sultanpur metro station in Delhi.
- The initiative is part of the **#OrangeTheWorld** global campaign.
- As part of the campaign, people would be made aware about India's single emergency helpline 112, an internationally recognised emergency number used in several countries.
- Under the campaign, people would be made aware of India's single emergency Response Support System helpline 112, which is launched by the Ministry of Home Affairs earlier in 2019.
- ♣ The 112 helpline services, available in 27 States/UTs (Union Territories), can be reached through voice call, 112 India App, SMS (Short message service), email, respective state's 112 websites, and the panic button on mobile phones.

# Parliament passes Jallianwala Bagh National Memorial (Amendment) Bill 2019

- Parliament has passed the Jallianwala Bagh National Memorial (Amendment) Bill, 2019. The Bill seeks to amend the Jallianwala Bagh National Memorial Act, 1951
- It has a provision to remove the President of the Congress party as a trustee and clarifies that when there is no Leader of the Opposition in the Lok Sabha, the leader of the single largest Opposition party will be the trustee.
- The Bill also allows the Central government to terminate the term of a nominated trustee before the expiry of the period of his term, without assigning any reason.





# Devendra Fadnavis takes oath as CM of Maharashtra

- Devendra Fadnavis of the BJP has taken oath as Maharashtra Chief Minister for a second time. Ajit Pawar of the NCP has also taken oath as Deputy Chief Minister.
- Maharashtra Governor Bhagat Singh Koshyari administered the oath to the two leaders. The BJP and NCP have formed an alliance to give a new government to Maharashtra after nearly a month-long wait after the results.

# Union Cabinet recommends President's rule in Maharashtra

- President Ram Nath Kovind has signed the proclamation imposing President's rule in Maharashtra. The Union Cabinet has recommended the President rule on the report of the Governor invoking Article 356 of the constitution in the state. The present-day Maharashtra came into existence on 1st may, 1960 and this is the 3rd time the state has come under the central rule.
- Article 356, commonly known as President's rule is applied where 'constitutional machinery has failed'. This implies that, whenever the state government is unable to function in accordance with the constitution, the state will come under the president rule i.e. under the direct control of the central government or the Government of India. In the above situation, the central government exercises executive authority through the Governor who is appointed by the Government of India.

#### Important points to be remembered:

- President's rule was imposed for the first time in India in the state of Punjab in 1951.
- The President's rule was imposed for the first time in Maharashtra in 1980 and the second time in 2014.
- Presently, Maharashtra is the only Indian state where President's Rule has been imposed.

# Sri Lanka becomes 1st South Asian country to call match fixing a crime

♣ Sri Lanka has become the first South Asian nation to bring match-fixing cases to the category of crime as its parliament passed a bill related to 'Prevention of Offences Related to Sports'. This new legislation related to match-fixing and corruption will apply to all sports & if a person is found guilty of corruption in the game, he can be punished for up to 10 years and also be required to pay other fines.

- The Union Minister for Rural Development, Panchayati Raj and Agriculture inaugurated the SARAS India International Trade Fair (IITF) Mela 2019 at Pragati Maidan, New Delhi.

- Union Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change is undertaking a mass cleanliness-cumawareness drive in 50 identified beaches under the programme called 'Swachh-Nirmal Tat Abhiyaan'.
- **39th India International Trade Fair 2019** begins in **New Delhi** with the theme of 'Ease of Doing **Business'**. - Gujarat Government has given approval to the world's first CNG terminal at Bhavnagar port, Gujarat. Joint venture of United Kingdom-based Foresight Group and Mumbai-based Padmanabh Mafatlal Group will invest 1,900 crore in the project.
- **4** The **Ministry of Environment** has granted clearance to the **Indian Oil Corporation Ltd** to set up a ₹ 766-crore **2G ethanol plant** in **Harvana's Panipat** district.
- The Assam State Commission for Protection of Child Rights is going to launch a mobile app Sishu Suraksha on the occasion of Children's Day to empower citizens to take moral responsibility for protecting future generations.
- The festival 'Bali Yatra' which is organised every year in memory of the rich maritime history of the state, was inaugurated in Cuttack, Odisha at the bank of Mahanadi River.
- **Uttar Pradesh** government has launched a dedicated web portal and a mobile application, **e-Ganna App**, for sugarcane farmers of the state which will ensure transparency in the process of getting slips, and facilitate sugarcane supply by farmers to mills and check irregularities.

  animal, Sangai, the brow-antlered deer found only in
  Manipur. It started in the year 2010 and has grown
  over the years into a big platform for Manipur to
  showcase its rich tradition and culture to the world.




