#### **Constitution Day of India 2019**

- **Constitution Day or Samvidhan Divas** is celebrated **26 November** cross the country to mark the adopting of the Indian Constitution by the Constituent Assembly on this day in 1949.
- In 2019, it marks the **70th anniversary of the** adoption of the Constitution.
- It came into force on 26th January 1950, marking the beginning of a new era in the history of the Indian Republic.
- It is aimed at reiterating and reorienting the citizens towards the values and principles expressed in the Constitution and encouraging all Indians to play their rightful role in strengthening the Indian Democracy.
- It also aims to create awareness of Fundamental Duties as enshrined in the Constitution.
- India's constitution is the longest written constitution in the world. It took around 2 years, 11 months and 17 days to complete the Constitution.

# RIL market cap hits 9.5 lakh crore, a first for an Indian company

- Reliance Industries Limited (RIL) is the first Indian company to cross Rs.9.5 lakh in market capitalization (m-cap).
- Recently Vodafone India and Bharti Airtel had announced their tariff hike which will be implemented from December 2019.
- This has increased the share price of RIL in the market and is believed to attract more subscribers for Reliance Jio.
- On 26 Nov 2019, its m-cap touched Rs 9,99,045 crore nearing the Rs 10 lakh crore mark.
- Tata Consultancy Services (TCS), RIL's closest rival in market capital had a share price of Rs.2,110, 2% lower on BSE and m-cap of Rs.7,71,996.87 crore.



#### **ISRO Launches CARTOSAT-3**

- India's Polar Satellite Launch Vehicle, PSLV-C47 Launch Vehicle-XL (PSLV-XL) rocket carrying advanced earth observation satellite Cartosat-3 and 13 US nano satellites lifted off from the second launch pad of the rocket port from Sriharikota.
- At about 9.28 a.m. the 44.4 meters tall, weighing 320-ton rocket blasted off from the second launch pad at the country's rocket port.
- The launch was normal despite a clouded sky.
- According to ISRO, the 1,625 kg Cartosat-3 is an advanced agile satellite to obtain panchromatic and multispectral imagery with an operational life of five years.

#### **Important Points:**

- **PSLV-C47** is the 21st flight of PSLV in the 'XL' configuration (with 6 solid strap-on motors). This will be the 74th launch vehicle mission from Sriharikota.
- Cartosat-3 satellite is a third-generation agile advanced satellite having high-resolution imaging capability. The satellite will be placed in an orbit of 509 km at an inclination of 97.5 degrees.
- PSLV-C47 will also carry 13 commercial nanosatellites from the United States of America as part of commercial arrangement with New Space India Limited (NSIL), Department of Space.

#### Logo, motto introduced for Lokpal

- Lokpal Chairman Justice (retired) **Pinaki Chandra Ghose** launched the new **logo and motto** for the apex anti-corruption ombudsman.
- A new motto, **"Ma Gridhah Kasyasvidhanam (Do not be greedy for anyone's wealth)",** was also adopted.
- Earlier, an open competition was conducted, inviting entries for the logo and the motto.
- A total of 2,236 entries for the logo and 4,705 entries for the motto were received.
- The logo symbolises how Lokpal protects and cares for the people of India by establishing justice as per law.

### Uddhav Thackeray takes oath as Maharashtra CM

- Shiv Sena Chief and Maha Vikas Aghadi nominee Uddhav Thackeray took oath as the Chief Minister of Maharashtra. He is the 19th Chief Minister of Maharashtra.
- He was named as the leader of the Shiv Sena-NCP-Congress alliance called the 'Maha Vikas Aghadi'.

- Governor of Maharashtra **Bhagat Singh Koshyari** administered the oath to Thackeray at Shivaji Park, Dadar in Central Mumbai.
- He is the first Thackeray family member to become Maharashtra's CM. The alliance is yet to decide the candidate for the Deputy CM post.

#### **National Affairs**

- Minister for Housing and Urban Affairs has launched Credit-linked Subsidy Services Awas Portal, CLAP, in New Delhi.
- Union Human Resource Development (HRD) Minister launched the kartavya.ugc.ac.in portal for holding monthly essay competitions for students. The portal was launched as part of year-long 'Nagrik Kartavya Paalan Abhiyan' being observed throughout the country.
- India wins bid to host 2023 Men's Hockey World Cup Kalinga Hockey Stadium in Bhubaneswar and Biju Patnaik Hockey Stadium in Rourkela to be the venues for the tournament.
- Defence Minister Rajnath Singh will inaugurate the 3-day-long **Military Literature Festival (MLF)** on 13 December 2019 at Chandigarh.
- The Transport Ministry has extended the **01st December** deadline for **100% electronic toll collection** across National Highways in the country by two weeks (15th December).

#### **States in the News**

- Every year the State of **Manipur** celebrates the "**Manipur Sangai Festival**" from 21st to 30th November. The 'Festival' is named after the State animal, Sangai, the brow-antlered deer found only in Manipur.
- Madhya Pradesh government has announced 5% reservation to national and international medallists sportspersons in state government jobs.



- The **Etawah Lion Safari**, formally known as **Etawah Safari Park** was thrown open for public in Uttar Pradesh without the lion segment.
- Chief Minister of **Odisha Naveen Patnaik** inaugurated the **National Tribal Craft Mela – 2019** in Bhubaneswar.
- Uttar Pradesh government is launching a massive immunisation campaign against the filariasis or Filaria.
- In a major step to conserve the endangered vulture population, the Uttar Pradesh government will set up the state's first vulture conservation and breeding centre in farenda area of Maharajganj district.
- The **Chhattisgarh** government has decided to declare **Guru Ghasidas National Park** in the state's Korea district as a tiger reserve.

#### **International Affairs**

- The **Ocean Dance Festival 2019** kicked off in Cox Bazar of **Bangladesh.** Ocean Dance Festival is the largest international dance festival of Bangladesh in which more than 200 dancers, choreographers and scholars from 15 countries are participating. The theme of this year's festival is 'Bridging the distance' or Durotter Shetubandhan.
- The European Union's legislature has declared a climate emergency, in a symbolic move aimed at increasing pressure on the incoming European Commission to take a stronger stance on climate change.

#### **Agreements/MoUs Signed**

- Commercial vehicle manufacturer **Ashok Leyland Ltd. (ALL)** has entered into a two- year memorandum of understanding (MoU) with **ICICI Bank** to offer customised financial solutions to customers across India with a focus on semi-urban and rural geographies.
- India and Uzbekistan have signed a pact for further strengthening of cooperation in the fields of counter-terrorism and organised crime.
- NewQuest-backed U GRO Capital inked an SME loan co-origination agreement with State Bank of India to facilitate broader credit outreach and faster disbursal.

#### **Books and Authors**

 On 11th anniversary of the 26/11 Mumbai terror attacks, a book titled "Hemant Karkare -A Daughter's Memoir" by his daughter Jui Karkare Navare was released in Mumbai, Maharashtra.



#### **Banking/Economy/Business News**

- The RBI expanded the scope of Special Non-Resident Rupee Accounts (SNRR account) by permitting non-residents to open such accounts for rupee-denominated overseas borrowings, trade credit and trade invoicing for popularising crossborder transactions in the domestic currency.
- Muthoot Finance Ltd, the largest gold loan nonbanking finance company in the country, entered into a definitive agreement to acquire IDBI Asset Management Ltd and IDBI Mutual Fund Trustee **Company Ltd.**
- Markets regulator SEBI imposed a total fine of Rs **40.5 lakh** on 7 companies for indulging in fraudulent trading in the illiquid stock options segment on the BSE.
- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has expressed concern over rising bad loans from Pradhan Mantri MUDRA Yojana (PMMY).
- The Asian Development Bank has approved the 2nd tranche of **USD 150 million** (about Rs 1,065 crore) for West Bengal to boost capital investment and infrastructure in the state.
- Global rating agency **Moody's** expects the Centre's fiscal deficit to touch **3.7%** of the GDP.
- India's GDP growth hit an over six-year low of 4.5 percent in July-September 2019, dragged mainly by the deceleration in manufacturing output and subdued farm sector activity. The Gross Domestic Product (GDP) growth was recorded at 7 percent in the corresponding quarter of FY 2018-19.
- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has imposed a monetary penalty of Rs. 1.50 crore on Corporation Bank for non-compliance with certain provisions of directions issued by RBI.



Non-bank lender Aditya Birla Finance became the first company to list its commercial papers borrowing of **Rs 100 crore on the bourses.** 

#### **Appointments/Resignations**

- Kerala cadre senior IAS officer Suman Billa is set to join the United Nations World Tourism Organisation (UNWTO) at its headquarters in Madrid, Spain.
- Chief Minister of Maharashtra Devendra Fadnavis announced his resignation after the Supreme Court asked him to face a floor-test to test the strength of his BJP-led government's position.
- General Bipin Rawat to be first Chief of Defence Staff. He will end his tenure as the Army Chief in December 2019.
- The Board of Tata Communications (Tata Comm) appointed Swaminathan Amur Lakshminarayanan as the managing director (MD) and chief executive officer (CEO) of the telecom company for a term of five years with effect from 26 November 2019.
- Former deputy governor of RBI, HR Khan has been appointed as the first chairman of the steering committee of the Code for Responsible Lending (CRL) in micro-credit.

#### **Defence News**

- The Indian Navy will host military drill 'Milan 2020' in March which will witness the participation of several countries. 41 nations from South Asia, Southeast Asia, Africa and Europe that share defence cooperation with India have been invited for the drill. MILAN stands for 'Multilateral Naval Exercise'.
- A maiden bilateral exercise between the Indian Navy and the Japanese Maritime Self Defence Force (JMSDF) have conducted Mine Countermeasure Exercise (MINEX) 2019 at Kochi, Kerala.
- The Indian Army has successfully test-fired 2 Spike long-range anti-tank missiles at Mhow in Madhya Pradesh.

#### Awards and Recognitions

- Eliud Kipchoge, the first man to run a marathon in less than two hours, and 400 metres hurdles world champion Dalilah Muhammad won the World Athlete of the Year awards.
- Floating school project of Bangladesh wins Aga Khan Architecture Award. Bangladesh is a land of water.

- Odia women weightlifter **Jhilli Dalabehera**, who has brought laurels for both the State and the country in several national and international events, will receive the **27th Ekalabya Award for 2019**.
- Singer **Billie Eilish** will be honoured as **Billboard's 2019 Woman of the Year.** Pop star Taylor Swift will also be honoured at Billboard's event, receiving the inaugural Woman of the Decade award.
- **Royal Aeronautical Society (RAeS) London** has conferred the Honorary Fellowship of the Society for the year 2019 to **G Satheesh Reddy,** Secretary Department of Defence R&D and Chairman DRDO. He is the first Indian recipient of this prestigious award in over 100 years.
- 'Particles' directed by Blaise Harrison and produced by Estelle Fialon has won the coveted Golden Peacock Award at the 50th International Film Festival of India (IFFI), which concluded in Goa on November 28, 2019.

- India will host the Shanghai Cooperation Organisation (SCO) Forum of Young Scientists and Innovators in 2020.
- Union Minister of Jal Shakti, represented India at the 8 WATEC (Water Technology and Environment Control) Conference 2019. The theme of the conference is "Water Stewardship and Innovation-driving global leadership in the responsible planning management, and protection of water".
- The DEFCOM INDIA 2019 seminar commenced at Manekshaw Centre, New Delhi. The theme for the seminar is, "Communications: A Decisive Catalyst for Jointness".
- The **47th All India Police Science Congress** (AIPSC) begins in Lucknow. The event will be inaugurated by Puducherry Lieutenant Governor and retired IPS officer Kiran Bedi.
- The International Centre for Automotive Technology (ICAT) is organizing a NuGen Mobility Summit, 2019 in Gurugram, Haryana.

 Minister of State for Home Affairs, inaugurated the 1st International Conference on "Landslides Risk Reduction and Resilience" in New Delhi.

- Microsoft rolled out its K12 Education Transformation Framework more widely to schools across India at the second edition of the Microsoft Education Days in Gurgaon.
- **NVIDIA** has announced a new kind of GPUaccelerated supercomputer in the cloud on Microsoft Azure. **NDv2** supercomputer is designed to handle demanding AI and high-performance computing applications, using up to 800 NVIDIA V100 Tensor Core GPUs interconnected on a single.
- ISRO has transferred its indigenous technology to produce space-grade Li-Ion cells to Bharat Heavy Electricals Limited (BHEL).


