RBI keeps the repo rate unchanged at 5.15% in 5th Bi-Monthly Monetary Policy

- In its **5th Bi-monthly Monetary Policy Committee** meeting, the Reserve Bank of India has decided to keep the policy repo rate unchanged to **5.15%**.
- The MPC has also decided to maintain the accommodative stance of monetary policy to revive growth, while ensuring that inflation remains within the target.
- The main decisions taken in the 5th Bi-Monthly Monetary Policy Committee meeting are:
- The repo rate under the **liquidity** adjustment facility (LAF) left unchanged to 5.15%.
- The reverse repo rate under the LAF stands same i.e. **4.90%**.
- The marginal standing facility (MSF) rate and the Bank Rate also remains same i.e. **5.40%**.
- RBI has also reduced the real **GDP growth** for 2019-20 from **6.1% to 5%**.

RBI releases "Guidelines for 'on tap' Licensing of SFB in the Private Sector"

- The Reserve Bank of India released guidelines for 'on tap' Licensing of Small Finance Banks in the Private Sector.
- Now payments banks willing to convert themselves into **small finance banks (SFBs)** can apply for such a licence only **after 5 years of operations.**
- Existing payments banks (PBs), which are controlled by residents and have completed five years of operations, are also eligible for conversion into small finance banks after complying with all legal and regulatory requirements of various authorities and if they conform to these guidelines.
- The licensing window will be open on-tap. The minimum capital for setting up an SFB has been mandated at **200 crores**, adding for primary (urban) co-operative banks

(UCBs), which wish to become SFBs, the initial requirement of net worth will be 2100 crores, which will have to be increased to 2200 crores within five years from the date of commencement of business.

 SFBs will be given scheduled bank status immediately upon commencement of operations.

NEFT transactions to be made 24×7 from December 16

- The **Reserve Bank of India** announced round-the-clock transactions will be allowed **24×7 facility** under the **National Electronic Funds Transfer (NEFT)** system on all days including weekends and holidays from December 16.
- These transactions after the usual banking hours are set to be automated initiated using 'Straight Through Processing (STP)' modes by the banks.
- The existing discipline for crediting the beneficiary's account or returning the transaction within 2 hours of settlement to the originating bank will also continue.
- Member banks are also advised to initiate necessary action and ensure availability of all necessary infrastructural requirements at their end for providing seamless NEFT 24×7 facility to their customers.

India becomes 1st country to make entire Haj process digital

- India has become the 1st country to make the entire process for pilgrims going on Haj completely digital.
- An online application, e-visa, Haj mobile app, 'e-MASIHA' health facility, "e-luggage pretagging" providing all information in India itself regarding accommodation and transportation in Mecca and Madina will be provided to 2 lakh Indian Muslims going for Haj in 2020.
- Minority Affairs Minister Mukhtar Abbas Naqvi signed the bilateral annual Haj 2020 agreement between India and Saudi Arabia with Haj and Umrah Minister of Saudi Arabia.

Nationwide vaccination drive launched under Mission Indradhanush 2.0


- The centre is launching a nationwide vaccination drive to prevent eight diseases under Intensified Mission Indradhanush 2.0 across the country.
- The government's flagship scheme is aimed at immunizing children under the age of 2 years and pregnant women against 8 vaccine-preventable diseases.
- The IMI covers vaccines for **diphtheria**, whooping cough, tetanus, poliomyelitis, tuberculosis, measles, meningitis and Hepatitis B. Vaccines for Japanese encephalitis and Hemophilus influenza are also being provided in selected areas.
- The IMI 2.0 aims to achieve targets of full immunization coverage in 272 districts spread over 27 States. The IMI 2.0 will be carried out between December 2019 and March 2020.

Vice Prez M Venkaiah Naidu launches Bharatiya POSHAN Anthem

- Vice President **M Venkaiah Naidu** launched the **'Bharatiya Poshan Anthem'** in New Delhi.
- The aims towards taking the message of making India malnutrition free to all corners of the country.
- The anthem was conceptualised by Union Ministry of Women and Child Development (MoWCD) and has been penned by noted lyricist Prasoon Joshi and sung by Shankar Mahadevan.

National Affairs

- Hallmarking of **gold jewellery and artefacts** will be made mandatory across the country from **January 15, 2021.** The step aims to ensure the purity of the precious metal.
 - Public sector trading firm MMTC has ordered import of **11,000 metric tonnes** of **onions from Turkey.**
 - The ElectionCommission of India willimplementthepoliticalpartiesRegistrationTrackingManagementSystem (RTMS).
- Union HRD Minister Ramesh Pokhriyal 'Nishank' and Minister of State for Youth Affairs & Sports Kiren Rijiju has jointly launched the Fit India School Rating System.
- The Central Government launched the **National Clean Air Programme (NCAP)** as a long-term, time-bound, national-level strategy to tackle the air pollution problem across the country in a comprehensive manner.

- Ministry of Information & Broadcasting is organising a "Multi Media Exhibition" at World War II museum, Kisama in Nagaland.
- President Ram Nath Kovind and Prime Minister Narendra Modi greeted the people of Nagaland on its 57th Statehood Day on 01st December 2019.
- The **20th Edition of Hornbill Festival** began with a colourful blend of culture and tradition with a modern twist at Naga Heritage Kisama **in Nagaland**.
- Donyi Polo Cultural & Charitable Trust and Indigenous Faith & Cultural Society of Arunachal Pradesh celebrated 'Indigenous Faith Day' on 1st December.
- Uttar Pradesh government has decided to provide 25 per cent subsidy and 100 per cent stamp duty waiver for setting up the defence industry in the state.

- The Union Minister for food processing inaugurated **Avantee mega Food Park** in **Dewas, Madhya Pradesh.**

International Affairs

- The **G20 Presidency** has been taken over by **Saudi Arabia from Japan.** Saudi Arabia has become the 1st Arab nation to assume the G20 presidency.
- Iraqi Prime Minister Adel Abdul Mahdi has submitted his resignation to Parliament amid ongoing anti-government protests across the country.
- The Global Migration Film Festival (GMFF) was organised in Dhaka, Bangladesh. The festival screened **15 films** on the theme of "migration and its various aspects".
- The National Assembly of Republic of Mauritius has unanimously elected Prithvirajsing Roopun, as new President of the island nation, a largely ceremonial post.

Schemes and Committees

 The government has launched a drive to enroll one crore beneficiaries under the Pradhan Mantri Shram Yogi Maandhan (PM-SYM) and the National Pension Scheme for Traders and Self Employed Persons (NPS-Traders) by March next year.

- The International Finance Corporation (IFC), a unit of the World Bank Group, has anchored an investment round of \$200million in Mahindra & Mahindra Financial Services Limited (MMFSL).
- Karnataka Vikas Grameena Bank (KVGB) and Canara, HSBC, Oriental Bank of Commerce, Life Insurance Company Ltd. signed an MoU for bancassurance (for selling life insurance products through the branches of KVGB).
 - The country's foreign exchange reserves crossed the **\$450-billion** mark for the first time ever on the back of strong inflows which enabled the central bank to buy dollars from the market, thus checking any sharp appreciation of the rupee.

Awards and Recognitions


