
Most Important Current Affairs of January

UN's World Economic Situation and Prospects Report 2020: Key findings of the report

- The United Nations has released its annual flagship report "World Economic Situation and Prospects Report 2020". The report depicts the state of the world economy through the lens of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development.
- The report is a result of the **joint efforts** of the United Nations Department of Economic and Social Affairs (UN DESA), the United Nations Conference on Trade and Development (UNCTAD) and the five United Nations regional commissions: Economic Commission for Africa (UNECA). Economic Commission for Europe (UNECE), Economic Commission for Latin America and the Caribbean (UNECLAC), Economic and Social Commission for Asia and the Pacific (UNESCAP) and Economic and Social Commission for Western Asia (UNESCWA). The United Nations World Tourism Organization (**UNWTO**), UN Office of the High Representative for the Least Developed Countries, Landlocked Developing Countries and Small Island Developing States (UN-OHRLLS), and the International Labour Organization (ILO) also gave their contribution to the report.

Key findings of the WESP Report 2020:

- Report states that the global growth dipped to a 10-year low of 2.3% in 2019 while it also projected the global growth rate at 2.5% in 2020 and 2.7% in 2021.
- Globally, the issue of per capita income stagnation or decline will be faced by 1 in every 5 countries in year 2020.



- For commodity-dependent developing countries, the average growth of GDP per capita has fallen from 2.9% per annum in the period 2010-2014 to only 0.5% in 2015–2019.
- The report has forecasted the expansion of aggregate GDP in least developed countries to 5.1% in 2020 and 5.4% in 2021.
- 85% of all monetary policy changes in 2019 headed towards easing rather than tightening and hence marked the broadest shift in global monetary policy since the global financial crisis.
- Between the period of 2010 and 2019, the part of government revenue spent on interest payments has increased in over 70% of the developing countries.
- Also, according to the WESP Report 2020, **East Asia** remains the **world fastest growing region**.

India ranked 51 in EIU's Democracy Index 2019

Economist Intelligence Unit (EIU) released the 12th edition of the "**Democracy Index 2019**: A year of democratic setbacks and popular protest". The Global Democracy Index is based on the functioning of government, election process and pluralism, political participation, political culture and civil liberties.

Based on their total score, countries are **classified into 4 types**:

- Governance full democracy (scoring more than 8 points)
- Flawed democracy (more than 6 but scoring 8 or less than 8)
- Hybrid regime (more than 4 but scoring 6 or less than 6)
- Authoritarian regime (having 4 or less)

Key results:


- **Norway tops** the list with a score of 9.87
- **North Korea** is at the bottom on 167th place with 1.08 points.
- World's biggest democracy India was placed at 51st position with 6.9 points.

50th Annual Meeting of WEF begins in Davos

The **50th Annual Meeting** of the **World Economic Forum** begins in **Davos, Switzerland.** Commerce and Industry Minister **Piyush Goyal** lead the Indian delegation to the WEF. This year programme will focus on achieving the maximum impact on the Forum's platform for public-private cooperation.



- The theme of 50th Annual Meeting of the World Economic Forum is "Stakeholders for a Cohesive and Sustainable World".
- The Programme for the Annual Meeting will prioritize six key areas: ecology, economy, society, industry, technology, and geopolitics.
- Ecology: How to mobilize business to respond to the risks of climate change and ensure that measures to protect biodiversity reach forest floors and ocean beds.
- Economy: How to remove the long-term debt burden and keep the economy working at a pace that allows higher inclusion.
- Technology: How to create a global consensus on deployment of Fourth Industrial Revolution technologies and avoid a 'technology war'.
- Society: How to reskill and upskill a billion people in the next decade.
- Geopolitics: How the 'spirit of Davos' can create bridges to resolve conflicts in global hotspots. Informal meetings to set kickstart conciliation.
- Industry: How to help business create the models necessary to drive enterprise in the Fourth Industrial Revolution. How to navigate an enterprise in a world exposed to political tensions and driven by exponential technological change as well as increasing expectations from all stakeholders.
- These initiatives aim to plant more than one trillion trees over the next decade and to equip one billion people with the necessary skills in the age of the 4th Industrial Revolution.
- Bollywood actress **Deepika Padukone** was presented with the the **annual crystal award** for her leadership in raising mental health awareness. These awards are given to cultural leaders, who are improving the state of the world through their contributions to inclusive and sustainable change.



Investment limit for FPIs in government & corporate bonds increased to 30%

The **investment limit** for **Foreign Portfolio Investors** (FPIs) in government and corporate bonds have been raised by the **Reserve Bank of India**. The decision aims to bring in more foreign funds into the market. The investment limit for Foreign Portfolio Investors (FPIs) have been raised from **20% to 30%** in **government** & **corporate bonds**.

Along with increase in the investment limit for Foreign Portfolio Investors, the RBI has also announced relaxations in the **voluntary retention route** (VRR) for FPI investments in debt. According to the RBI circular, the **investment cap** through VRR has been increased to **Rs 1.5 lakh crore** from Rs 0.75 lakh crore. The central bank has also permitted the FPIs to invest in exchange-traded funds that invest only in debt instruments.

Maharashtra topped the medal tally of Khelo India Youth Games 2020

- The 3rd season of the Khelo India Youth Games concluded in Guwahati, Assam. Maharashtra retained its reign in the Khelo India Youth Games with 256 medals including 78 gold. Haryana stood second with a total of 200 medals. Delhi finished third with 122 medals
- Shivangi Sharma of Assam won five gold and two silver in swimming. She was the **most successful female player** of the Khelo India Youth Games.
- Vijay the Tiger and Jaya the Blackbuck were the mascots of the tournament. Sprinter Hima Das was the torchbearer of the opening ceremony of KIYG 2020.

Union Minister Smriti Irani launched 3 welfare schemes in Goa

The Union minister for women and child development Smriti Irani launched **3 welfare schemes** for women in **Goa**. The schemes are **Yashaswini Scheme** for Women Entrepreneurship, **Swasthya Sahayak Project** and **breast cancer screening initiative** handheld device facilitating detection of cancer.

 Under the Yashaswini Scheme for Women Entrepreneurship, the state government provides interest-free loan up to Rs 5 lakh with a tenure of 5 years to self-help groups with repayment starting from the second year and the loan to be paid in four instalments.

- Under the Swasthya Sahayak scheme, a diagnostic kit will be supplied to primary healthcare workers and Anganwadi workers in the state to help them conduct basic diagnostic tests at people's doorstep so as to bring an affordable and convenient solution to the common man. The diagnostic kit has been developed by the Public Health Foundation of India, which has partnered with Procter and Gamble to manufacture and supply the kits using corporate social responsibility (CSR) fund.
- Under breast cancer screening initiative handheld device, the Anganwadi and healthcare workers will screen women for breast cancer, reaching out to the women in rural parts of the state.

National Affairs

- Union Minister for Heavy Industries Prakash Javadekar inaugurated ELECRAMA 2020 in Greater Noida, Uttar Pradesh.
- 12th National Tribal Youth Exchange Programme was jointly organized by the Nehru Yuva Kendra Sangathan (NYKS) and Puducherry Government in Puducherry.
- The Integrated Check-Post (ICP) in Biratnagar has been inaugurated at India-Nepal border with modern facilities like electronic weighbridges, fire safety, warehousing facilities and 24×7 monitoring through CCTV.
- President of Brazil Jair Messias Bolsonaro will be the chief guest at the 71st Republic Day Parade at Raj Path, New Delhi on 26 January.
- The Government of India has created "National Startup Advisory Council" to advise the central government to create a strong ecosystem to nurture innovation and start-ups in India. Commerce Minister will be the chairman of the Council.
- India's first Mahatma Gandhi convention centre opens in Niger to honour the memory of Mahatma Gandhi.
- The Election Commission of India has received the approval from the Union Cabinet to sign MoU with Papua New Guinea Electoral Commission and Independent High Authority for Elections of Tunisia to enhance the cooperation in the field of electoral management and administration.
- The Union Cabinet has approved the agreements in the field of mutual Legal Assistance in Criminal Matters, cooperation in the field of early childhood care, oil and natural gas, and Geology and Mineral Resources between India and Brazil.



States in the News

- Uttarakhand has become the 1st state in the country to implement Agricultural land leasing policy.
- Reading of the Preamble of the Constitution has been made mandatory by the government of Maharashtra in all primary and secondary schools in Maharashtra.
- Uttar Pradesh Government has launched Mukhyamantri Krishak Durghatna Kalyan Yojana to provide financial assistance to the family of farmers who die or become handicapped while working in fields. The scheme will cover farmers and their family members in the age group of 18-70 years.
- Uttar Pradesh government will implement Mukhyamantri Paryatan Samvardhan Yojana to boost tourism in the state.
- Meghalaya celebrated its 48th anniversary of statehood day on 21 January.
- Government of Mizoram will celebrate Chapchar Kut festival on March 6, 2020. The festival is celebrated after completion of the Jhum cultivation also known as the slash and burn agriculture.

International Affairs

- Union Minister of State for Shipping (I/C) Mansukh Mandaviya participated in the High-level roundtable of United Nations AIDS (UNAIDS) programme at the World Economic Forum in Davos, Switzerland with theme "Access for all: Leveraging Innovations, Investments and Partnerships for Health".
- The Parliament of Greece has elected Katerina Sakellaropoulou as the country's first female president.

Agreements/MoUs Signed

- The Government of India and the Government of Maharashtra has signed a USD 210 million loan agreement with the World Bank for Maharashtra Agribusiness and Rural Transformation Project. The loan will be funded by the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development (IBRD), having a 6year grace period with a maturity period of 13.5 years.
- Indian Oil has signed an MoU with Ghana's National Petroleum Authority to provide its technical expertise and assistance for proper execution of the Ghana's National LPG Promotion Policy.



- Hyderabad Metro Rail Limited has partnered with online bus ticketing platform redBus to start carpool service for train passengers to provide end to end connectivity to daily commuters in an affordable manner. The service will be offered through "rPool".
- The Indian Institute of Management (IIM) Indore has signed an memorandum of understanding with the Uttar Pradesh Police to provide effective communication and crowd management training to the Uttar Pradesh Police personnel.

Banking/Economy/Business News

- National Payments Corporation of India has launched payment system 'Vajra Platform' based on the Distributed Ledger Technology (DLT). It aims to automate payment clearing and settlement processes of NPCI products such as unified payments interface (UPI) and Rupay card. The platform has three types of nodes: Clearing House node for NPCI; UIDAI node for Aadhaar authentication; Participant node (PN) for all banks.
- ICICI Bank has rolled out "Cardless Cash Withdrawal" service through ATM by putting a request on ICICI Internet Banking App "iMobile".
 The service can be used for cash withdrawal having a per day transaction limit of Rs 20,000.
- The **Reserve Bank of India** has cancelled the **Certificate of Authorisation** (CoA) of **Vodafone m-pesa** after its voluntary surrender of authorisation.
- Adani Capital Private Ltd has acquired Essel Finance's micro, small and medium enterprises (MSME) loan business.
- The **United Nations** has lowered **India's GDP growth rate** to **5.7%** for the Fiscal Year 2019-20 in its World Economic Situation and Prospects (WESP) 2020 report. It has also projected India's growth rate at 6.6% for FY 2020-21 and 6.3% for FY 2021-22. According to the UN, India's growth rate for FY 2018-19 was 6.8%.
- The **International Monetary Fund** (IMF) has estimated India's growth rate for the fiscal year 2019 as **4.8%**. IMF has also projected India's growth rate as 5.8% in 2020 and 6.5% in 2021.


