# Union Budget 2020-21 is being presented by FM Nirmala Sitharaman

- Union Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman is presenting the Union Budget 2020 for the 2nd time in a row. The Union Budget is the yearly financial report estimating the income and expenditure presented to outline future policies to be adopted by the government for sustainable growth and development. The Economic Survey 2019-20 was released on 31st January 2020 by the Chief Economic Advisor of India, Krishnamurthy Subramanian. The GDP growth of India's forecasts at between 6 to 6.5% for the fiscal year starting April. Sabka Sath, Sabka Vikas, **Sabka Vishwas** was the tagline of government mentioned by Finance Minister Nirmala Sithraman in her speech.
- This time 3 themes of Union Budget 2020-21:
  - 1. aspirational India,
  - 2. economic development for all, and
  - 3. develop a caring society

- Finance Minister, **Nirmala Sitharaman** presented **Economic Survey 2019-20** in the Parliament today (31 January 2020). This year's Economic survey is being prepared by the Chief Economic Advisor, **Krishnamurthy V Subramanian**.
- The report will be followed by a press conference where the Chief Economic Advisor and his team will discuss the economic roadmap for the next fiscal. It is a review of the developments in the country's economy over the previous year. It presents a summary of the performance of the government's major development programmes undertaken during

that period. It also details the main policy initiatives of the government.

- **Padma Awards** one of the highest civilian • Awards of the country, are conferred in three categories, namely, Padma Vibhushan, Padma Bhushan and Padma Shri. The Awards are given in various disciplines/ fields of activities. viz. art, social work, public affairs, science and engineering, trade and industry, medicine, literature and education, sports, civil service, 'Padma Vibhushan' is awarded for etc. exceptional and distinguished service; 'Padma Bhushan' for distinguished service of high order and 'Padma Shri' for distinguished service in any field. The awards are announced on the occasion of Republic Day every year.
  - This year the President has approved conferment of 141 Padma Awards including 4 duo cases (in a duo case, the award is counted as one) as per list below. The list comprises 7 Padma Vibhushan, 16 Padma Bhushan and 118 Padma Shri Awards. 33 of the awardees are women and the list also includes 18 persons from the category of Foreigners/NRI/PIO/OCI and 12 Posthumous awardees.

#### Republic Day 2020: India celebrates its 71st Republic Day

• The nation celebrated the **71st Republic Day** with a grand military parade and exhibition of its history, cultural diversity and strategic weaponry at the Rajpath, Delhi. This day is celebrated by all Indians and **26th of January** has been declared as a national holiday by the government of India. The Republic Day ceremony commenced with Prime Minister Narendra Modi paying homage to martyrs at the National War Memorial instead of Amar Jawan Jyoti. The National Flag was unfurled followed by the National Anthem with a booming 21-gun salute.

#### Important Facts of 71st Republic Day:

- The chief guest for this year's republic day parade is Brazilian president, Jair Messias Bolsonaro.
- For the first time, a contingent of women bikers of **CRPF** performed daredevil stunts.
- **Jammu and Kashmir** participated in the parade for the first time as a Union Territory.



- Meghalava's Tableau depicted the Double Decker Living Root Bridge which is a main tourist attraction of the state.
- Telangana's tableau brought to life its floral • festival called Bathukamma.
- The Tableau of Gujarat was on the theme Rani • ki Vav – Jal Mandir which is a unique piece of ancient Indian architectural style, construction work and craftsmanship.
- The Air Force tableau displayed models of the • Rafale aircraft, Tejas aircraft, Light Combat Helicopter, Akash Missiles System and Astra Missiles.
- The major attraction was fly-past by the newly • inducted Chinook and Apache helicopters along with Sukhoi and advanced light helicopters.
- Anti-satellite weapons: Mission Shakti, Army's • battle tank Bhishma was also showcased in the parade.

# **Republic Day Of India: Importance**


- India became independent on 15th of august, • 1947. Even after independence, the country did not have a sound constitution. The laws, before the enactment of the constitution, were running on the basis of Government of India Act 1935. Having realized the need for a permanent constitution and its own governing body, the government of India appointed a Drafting Committee on 28th of August 1947 to draft it and Dr, B. R. Ambedkar as the Chairman of the Drafting Committee.
- After almost 3 years, the 308 members of the • Assembly, after many consultations and a few modifications finally signed a constitution on 24th of January 1950, which came into effect on 26th of January 1950. And, that day, is being celebrated as Republic Day in India ever since then. This day defines the importance of having a proper constitution that all the citizens must abide by.


# Andra cabinet adopts resolution to abolish **Legislative Council**

- Andhra Pradesh (AP) cabinet has adopted a abolition legislative resolution to the **council**, which the government feels is a major hurdle for passing crucial bills. This cabinet chaired by the chief minister (CM) YS Jaganmohan Reddy.
- This approval came after AP government failed to pass 2 important bills (Andhra Pradesh Decentralization and Inclusive development of All Regions Bill-2020 for the tri-capital system & and the AP Capital Region Development Authority (CRDA) Act (Repeal) Bill) in the upper house of the legislature.

# Tableaux of Assam wins 1st prize at 71st **Republic Day parade**

The **Tableaux of Assam** wins the 1st prize at the **Republic Day Parade**, 2020 among the States/Union Territories. The theme of Assam's tableau was "Land of unique craftsmanship and culture", displaying bamboo and cane work and Bhortal Nritya performed by Xattriya dancers. Best Tableaux awards for Republic Day Parade, 2020 was given by Defence Minister Rajnath Singh.









- Odisha and Uttar Pradesh won tied second prize. Odisha's tableau depicted Lord Lingaraja's Rukuna Rath Yatra whereas the tableau of Uttar Pradesh showcased the state's cultural and religious heritage.
- The tableaux of National Disaster Relief Force (NDRF) and Jal Shakti Mission have jointly adjudged the best tableau among the Ministries and Departments. Central Public Works Department (CPWD) got the Special Prize for their tableau based on the theme Kashmir se Kanyakumari.

#### "Samvidhaan" announced as the Oxford Hindi Word of the Year 2019

- Oxford University Press (OUP) named "Samvidhaan" (Constitution) the Oxford Hindi Word of 2019. It received widespread attention in the year which was witness to the spirit of the Indian Constitution being embraced across segments of the society. The word was chosen as 2019 saw the values of democracy, secularism, justice, liberty, equality and fraternity being tested on the touchstone of the Constitution or "Samvidhaan".
- "Samvidhaan" means a "body of fundamental principles or established precedents according to which a state or other organisation is acknowledged to be governed".

#### **National Affairs**

- A festival to celebrate the spirit of India "Bharat Parv 2020" has begun at Red Fort Ground in New Delhi. The objective of Bharat Parv is to encourage people to visit different tourist places of the country and to inculcate the spirit of 'Dekho Apna Desh'. The theme of this year's Bharat Parv is 'Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat' and 'Celebrating 150 Years of Mahatma Gandhi.
- Union Minister of State for PMO Jitendra Singh launched the Bhuvan Panchayat V3 web Portal in Anthariksh Bhavan, ISRO Head Quarters in Bengaluru. This web Portal will

enhance network application of gram panchayats. The Portal will function with the help of satellite technology developby **ISRO**.

- Indian Railways has commissioned India's 1st governmental waste-to-energy plant in Mancheswar Carriage Repair workshop at Bhubaneswar under the East Coast Railway zone.
- World's largest meditation centre was inaugurated at Kanha Shanti Vanam in Hyderabad, Telangana.

- India's first **e-waste clinic** is being opened in **Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh.**
- Chief Minister of **Kerala Pinarayi Vijayan** inaugurates India's **1st Super Fab Lab in Kochi, Kerala.**
- Maharashtra government launched **'Shiv Bhojan'** scheme. The scheme aims to provide a meal to the poor for just 10 rupees, on the occasion of the 71st Republic Day.
- The State Government of **Odisha** has launched a virtual police station where people can lodge complaints from their respective districts without visiting Police Station.
- The state government also launched the medico-legal opinion system and road accident case document module at Lok Seva Bhawan in the capital.







- The Chief Minister of Maharashtra Uddhav Thackeray inaugurated 18.5 kilometre-long stretch of **Nagpur Metro Aqua line of Maha Metro Rail Network.** This Line will have six stations starting from Lokmanya Nagar to Sitabuldi Interchange Metro Station.
- President Ram Nath Kovind will inaugurate the 34th Surajkund International Crafts Fair on February 1, 2020. The partner country of the fair is Uzbekistan. The state of Himachal Pradesh has been chosen to be the Theme State.

- **Britain** has unveiled a new 50 pence coin minted to mark **Brexit (British exit).** Brexit is the withdrawal of the United Kingdom (UK) from the European Union (EU). The coin bears the inscription "Peace, prosperity and friendship with all nations".
- Qatar's emir has appointed Sheikh Khalid bin Khalifa bin Abdelaziz Al Thani as new Prime Minister.
- **The European Union parliament** has approved United Kingdom Brexit deal.
- US President Donald Trump has signed the new United States-Mexico-Canada Agreement (USMCA) North American trade pact with Canada and Mexico into law.
- World Health Organization has declared an international emergency over the novel coronavirus from China. The organization has declared an emergency as the disease has spread to 18 other countries apart from China where it originated.

 The Bombay Stock Exchange (BSE) has signed a licensing agreement with Intercontinental Exchange (ICE) Futures Europe. Intercontinental Exchange (ICE) Futures Europe is an operator of global exchanges and clearinghouses.

• **Google** announced a **1-million USD** grant to promote news literacy among Indians. According to Google, the grant will work towards building a strong network of senior reporters and journalists, who will counteract fake news in India. The funding support is part of Google's broader, **\$10-million commitment to media literacy**.

- Sunil Mehta took over as the Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of the Indian Banks' Association (IBA). He will replace VG Kannan.
- **Taranjit Singh Sandhu** takes charge as the new Indian Ambassador to the United States. He will succeed **Ambassador Harsh Vardhan Shringla**.
- Prime Minister of Slovenian Marjan Sarec announced his resignation and called for new elections as the country's coalition struggles with political deadlock.
  - The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) appointed its Executive Director Janak Raj as member of the Monetary Policy Committee (MPC). He will replace M D Patra.

- **Defence PSU** Garden Reach Shipbuilders and Engineers (GRSE) is set to deliver antisubmarine warfare stealth corvette INS Kavaratti to the Indian Navy.
- Indian Navy has launched "Operation Vanilla" to provide humanitarian assistance and disaster relief at Madagascar.
- The **Assam Rifles** has constructed a combined war memorial in Nagaland. The memorial has been built for the 357 Army and Assam Rifles personnel killed while fighting insurgency in the northeastern state.





- Indian Coast Guard (ICG) has commissioned a high-speed interceptor boat C-448 in Mangaluru, Karnataka.
- The 9th edition of joint military training exercise between India-Bangladesh SAMPRITI-IX will be conducted at Umroi, Meghalaya.
- The **AN-32 aircraft of Indian Air Force** powered with **10% blend of bio-jet fuel** took off and landed successfully in **Leh airport**.

#### Science and Technology


