National Science Day celebrated on 28th February across India

- National Science Day is celebrated all over India on 28th February. On this day, Sir CV Raman had announced the discovery of the Raman Effect for which he was awarded the Nobel Prize in 1930. Government of India designated 28 February as National Science Day (NSD) in 1986.
- The theme for this year's National Science Day is **'Women in Science'**. This theme has been chosen for the purpose of increasing public appreciation of the scientific issues involved. The main event of the National Science Day will take place at the Vigyan Bhavan in New Delhi. President Ram Nath will be present at the event.
- On this occasion, President Ram Nath Kovind will present awards for science communication as well as for women scientists. A total of 21 awards will be given which will include National Science and Technology and Communication Awards, Augmenting Writing Skills For Articulating Research awards and National Award For Young Woman Showing Excellence Through Application Of Technology For Societal Benefits.

India ranked 3rd in Hurun Global Rich List 2020

• Hurun Report has released the **Hurun Global Rich List 2020.** The Hurun Global Rich List 2020 is a ranking of the US-Dollar billionaires in the world. The **9th edition of the Hurun Global Rich list ranked 2,816 billionaires from 71 countries and from 2,182 companies.**

Some key facts of the list:

- Among the countries, the list has been topped by China with 799 Billionaires and USA stood on the 2nd position with 626 Billionaires.
- Among individuals, **Jeff Bezos** has topped the list of richest person in the world with the total wealth of US\$ 140 Bn.
- For the 5th time, Beijing (China) remained the capital of world's billionaire with 110 billionaires living at the place.
- Total four individuals recorded wealth of over US\$ 100 Bn.
- Mukesh Ambani stood 9th in the global rich list along with Larry Page and Steve Ballmer with a wealth of US\$ 67 Bn. Mukesh Ambani was also the only one from Asian region in the top-10 list.

Elections for 55 Rajya Sabha seats to be conducted on March 26

- The Election Commission of India (ECI) announcing the schedule of polling for 55 Rajya Sabha seats spread over 17 States set to be vacated in April will be conducted on March 26. According to the schedule for the elections, the notification would be issued on March 6, the last date of filing of nominations would be March 13 and polling would be on March 26, from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. The votes would be counted at 5 p.m. on the same day.
- Prominent leaders who are retiring in April, are NCP leader Sharad Pawar, Union Minister Ramdas Athawale, Congress veteran Motilal Vora, Digvijay Singh of Congress and former Union Minister Vijay Goel. Maximum seven seats are falling vacant in Maharashtra followed by six seats in Tamil Nadu.

POTUS in India: Events of 24th February 2020

- **President of the United States (POTUS)** Donald Trump has arrived in India on **24th February 2020.** He was accompanied by the First Lady of the **United States Melania Trump.** With this, Donald Trump has become the first serving US President to visit Gujarat.
- After his arrival, the US president was welcomed by the Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi. After welcome, the cavalcade of US president head towards Sabarmati Ashram. After reaching the Sabarmati Ashram, the US president and the first lady of US spun the Charkha and then head towards the Motera Stadium in Ahmedabad for "Namaste Trump" event.

"NAMASTE TRUMP" Event:

• Following the Sabarmati Ashram visit, both the leaders arrived at the world's largest cricket stadium **"Sardar Patel Stadium"** which is also known as **"Motera Stadium"** to attend and address the "NAMASTE TRUMP" event. The "NAMASTE TRUMP" event featured cultural performances.

Taj Mahal Visit:

• Following the "NAMASTE TRUMP" event, the US delegate landed at Kheria Airport, Agra, Uttar Pradesh to visit one of the 7 wonders of the world, i.e. the iconic "Taj Mahal" in Agra. At the airport, the US President and the first lady were received by Uttar Pradesh's Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath and Governor Anandiben Patel. The US President and the first lady arrived at the iconic Taj Mahal and admired the beauty of the historical monument. After the Taj Mahal visit, the US delegates returned to Delhi for the rest of their trip.

US becomes India's top trading partner, surpassing China

- The United States has surpassed China to become India's top trading partner. According to the Commerce Ministry data, the bilateral trade between the US and India stood at nearly 88 billion dollars in 2018-19 fiscal. During the period, India's trade with China was at 87.1 billion dollars. During April-December 2019-20, the bilateral trade between the US and India stood at 68 billion dollars against a nearly 65 billion dollars trade with China in the same period.
- The countries will finalise a free trade agreement (FTA), then the bilateral trade would reach different levels. FTA with the US will be very beneficial for India as the US is the biggest market for domestic goods and services.
- India's exports, as well as imports, are increasing with the US, while with China both are declining. America is one of the few countries with which India has a trade surplus. On the other hand, India has a huge trade deficit with China. The data showed that China was India's top trading partner since 2013-14 till 2017-18.

India & US sign defence deals worth \$3 billion

- India and the United States finalized defence deals worth 3 billion dollars. India has agreed to purchase USD 3 billion worth advanced American military equipment including Apache and MH-60 Romeo helicopters, which are the finest in the world.
- The deals were signed after delegation-level talks between Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi and visiting US President Donald Trump. Under a USD 2.6 billion deal, India will buy 24 MH-60 Romeo helicopters from Lockheed Martin for the Indian Navy. Another contract to acquire six AH-64E Apache helicopters for USD 800 million from aerospace giant Boeing has also been sealed.
- Defence and security ties between India and the US have been on an upswing in the last six years. The bilateral defence trade touched USD 18 billion marks in 2019, reflecting growing defence cooperation between the two sides.

ISRO to launch Geo Imaging Satellite "GISAT-1"

• The Indian Space Research Organisation will launch the Geo Imaging Satellite "GISAT-1". GISAT-1 will be launched by Geosynchronous Satellite Launch Vehicle (GSLV-F10) from the Second Launch Pad of Satish Dhawan Space Centre (SDSC) SHAR, Sriharikota. The launch of GISAT-1 has been tentatively scheduled at 17:43 Hrs IST on March 05, 2020.

About GISAT-1:

• The Geo Imaging Satellite "GISAT-1" is an agile Earth observation satellite which has been planned to be placed in a Geosynchronous Transfer Orbit by GSLV-F10. The satellite weighing about 2275 kg will reach the final geostationary orbit with the help of onboard propulsion system installed on it. The GSLV flight will be carrying an Ogive shaped payload having a diameter of 4 metre.

National Affairs

- The **Indian Railways** has launched the Hindi Version of **Artificial Intelligence-based chatbot called "ASKDISHA".** The hindi version has been launched to further enhance the customer services rendered and to further strengthen the services of the chatbot.
- The first anniversary of the iconic **National War Memorial** is being observed on **25th February**. The memorial is a fitting tribute to those heroes who sacrificed their lives in the line of duty during various wars and internal security challenges since Independence.
- The Joint Ministerial Commission (JMC) between India and Australia was held in New Delhi. This was the 16th edition of the session.
- Union Minister of **Food Processing Industries** Harsimrat Kaur Badal has launched the- **Market Intelligence and Early Warning System (MIEWS)** Web Portal. The portal can be accessed at http://miews.nafedindia.com.
- A Programme for **Capacity Building of Scheduled Tribe Representatives in Local Self Governments** has been launched in Bhubhaneswar, Odisha. The programme was launched by the Union Tribal Affairs Minister Shri Arjun Munda.
- The **91st Annual General Meeting of the Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR)** Society was held in Delhi. The Annual General Meeting was chaired by the Union Minister for Agriculture & Farmers' Welfare, Shri Narendra Singh Tomar.

- The **Ministry of Food Processing Industries(MoFPI)** has approved **Rs 162 crore** under **Operation Green scheme** which has an outlay of Rs 500 crore to stabilize the supply of tomato, onion and potato (TOP) crops and to ensure their availability round the year without price volatility.

States in the News

- Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister Y S Jagan Mohan Reddy has launched a scheme named 'Jagananna Vasthi Deevena'. This scheme is for students pursuing various post-Intermediate courses to meet hostel and mess expenses.
- Madhya Pradesh has become the 1st state in the country to introduce the unified registration card and the 2nd state to launch the unified driving license after Uttar Pradesh.
- Losar festival was celebrated at Dharamshala, Himachal Pradesh. The festival is celebrated on the 1st day of the lunisolar Tibetan calendar also called Tibetan New Year. Losar is a festival in Tibetan Buddhism.
- The department of Youth and cultural Affairs, Government of Gujarat has organised cultural festival called **"Vasantotsav"**. The cultural festival "Vasantotsav" was held with the theme of "Ek Bhaart Shreshth Bharat".
- **Maharashtra government** has decided to undertake the genetic study for the conservation of the native species of domesticated animals. The genetic study aims to conserve the native species of domesticated animals in the Marathwada region of Maharashtra.
- Union Communications-Electronics IT Law and Justice Minister Ravi Shankar Prasad inaugurated **BSNL FTTH and WiFi services at Jolly Grant Airport in Dehradun.**
- The Uttar Pradesh Cabinet has approved a proposal to change the name of Khwaja Moinuddin Chishti Urdu, Arabi-Farsi University in Lucknow. The Cabinet has decided to rename the university as Khwaja Moinuddin Chishti Languages University.
- The **Kerala High Court** recently passed an order and **banned all types of political movements in the college and school premises.** Banning various forms agitations like gherao and sit-in in the campuses, the High Court also said no one can be persuaded to participate in such protests.

International Affairs

- **South Sudan** rebel leader **Riek Machar** has been sworn in as first vice president. He is formally rejoining the government in the latest effort to bring peace to a nation ravaged by war.
- **Malaysian** Prime Minister **Mahathir Mohamad** has announced his resignation over political issues. He will act as an interim PM.
- Sri Lankan Government formally notified the United Nations that it will withdraw from the UNHRC (United Nations Human Rights Council) resolution for investigating alleged war crimes. The case was dealing with a decade-old clash with Tamil separatists.

Agreements/MoUs Signed

- **Microsoft** announced a partnership with **State Bank of India** to train differently-abled people to find jobs in the banking, financial services and insurance (BFSI) sector.
- Chinese tech major Xiaomi will bring ISRO's Indian Regional Navigation Satellite System, NavIC technology to its smartphones.
- The NTPC Ltd has signed an agreement with the Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB). According to an agreement, NTPC Ltd will provide financial support of Rs 80 Crore for installation and commissioning of Continuous Ambient Air Quality Monitoring Stations (CAAQMS).
- **HDFC Bank** joined hands with the country's largest airline **IndiGo** to launch a co-branded credit card, which will effectively work like a loyalty programme for the carrier. Its first travel credit card named **'Ka-ching'**-powered by **Mastercard**.

- An interactive AI Powered **ChatBot solution "LIDEA"** has been launched by Birla Estates for its customers. "LIDEA" will enable the users to access authentic information of the projects which can be used for the evaluation of the residential developments of Birla Estates.
- Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) has allowed the use of regulatory sandbox by the market players on select customers. SEBI will also grant limited registration for such testing purposes. The decision is expected to facilitate the use of latest fintech innovations in capital markets.
- National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development (NABARD) has sanctioned 400.64 crore rupees to the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir. This sanction is for giving a boost to the infrastructure in the rural areas of J&K.
- National Payments Corporation of India (NPCI) has launched an industry campaign named "UPI Chalega" to promote UPI as Easy, Safe, and Instant mode of payment.

- The **"UPI Chalega"** campaign is aimed to guide users towards the right usage of Unified Payments Interface (UPI) and help create a habitual change, use of UPI in their daily life. NPCI has launched the campaign in association with the payment ecosystem players.
- The **Reserve bank of India** removes the restrictions placed on **Bandhan Bank**, allowing it to open new branches without prior permission. The RBI came up with some regulatory conditions & directed the bank to order about 25% of the total banking outlets to be opened in rural areas where banking facilities are not available.
- The **Asian Development Bank (ADB)** has raised **Rs 850 crore (USD 118 million)** from a new issue of offshore Indian rupee-linked 10-year bonds.
- The Airtel Payments Bank has launched the Aadhaarenabled Payment System (AePS). The facility has been launched by the payment bank at over 2,50,000 banking points across India.
- Bharti AXA General Insurance, a private non-life insurer becomes the 1st company in India to use Whatsapp chatbot. Through this service, the company started delivering policies and renewal premium to its customers. It plans to sell the private car, two-wheeler and travel insurance through a WhatsApp chatbot.
- The **Reserve Bank of India** has directed all Scheduled Commercial Banks (excluding RRBs), all Small Finance Banks and all Local Area Banks to link all the new floating rate loans to medium enterprises with external benchmarks. The decision has been taken by the RBI to further strengthen the monetary policy transmission.
- Finance Secretary Rajiv Kumar inaugurated "Baroda Startup Banking". It is an initiative aimed at making the Bank of Baroda (BoB) a preferred banking partner for the start-up community and establishing connect with at least 2,000 start-ups over the next two years. The initiative was launched simultaneously across 15 cities in the country.

- **Mastercard Chief Executive Officer Ajay Banga** will step down at the start of the next year and will be replaced by Chief Product Officer Michael Miebach.


- **TransUnion Cibil,** the largest credit information bureau appointed **Rajesh Kumar of HDFC Bank** as its new managing director and chief executive.
