S1. Ans. (c)

Sol. Statement I can be assumed from the given statement as the reason behind increase in funding can be the alarming challenge of climate change which require more focus and fund to deal with it. Statement II can't be assumed from the given statement as we can't compare the problem of climate change with other global issues.

S2. Ans.(d)

Sol. In the above question it is clear that Statement II will be the cause and Statement I will be its effect. Because it is mentioned in statement II that jawans have doubt how to deal with the women so this will be cause and its effect will be, The Indian Army will recruit women in combat roles to tackle such kind of situation.

S3. Ans.(c)

Sol. Statement (I) suggests that royals are not kings or queens by choice but because they have to, for the welfare of the country which is in line with the statement. (II) fortifies the statement by stating out an example in which he had to face problems because of his royal background. (III) is irrelevant to the statement.

S6. Ans.(c)
