PM, President and MPs Salary Cut by 30% , MPLAD funds suspended for 2 years

The **Union Cabinet** approved an ordinance amending the salary, allowances and pension of Members of Parliament Act, 1954, to reduce the allowances and pension by 30% starting April 1, 2020, for a year. All Members of Parliament (MPs), including Prime Minister Narendra Modi and his Council of Ministers, would be taking a 30 per cent salary cut due to the impact of the novel coronavirus. Indian President, Vice President and all state governors have voluntarily decided to take a 30 per cent salary cut for a year in view of the coronavirus outbreak and the expected downturn in the economy. The cabinet also approved temporary suspension of MPLAD (Member of Parliament Local Area Development) fund scheme during 2020-21 and 2021-22, and the funds will be used for managing health services and the adverse impact of COVID-19 pandemic in the country. **Rs 7,900 crore** from the MPLADS scheme will go to Consolidated Fund of India. The Rs 10 crore from each MPLAD fund will now go to the Consolidated Fund of India for "managing health and the adverse impact of the outbreak of COVID-19 in India". India is under a 21-day nationwide lockdown to mitigate the spread of the novel coronavirus.

#### What is MPLADS?

The **Members of Parliament Local Area Development Division** is entrusted with the responsibility of implementation of Members of Parliament Local Area Development Scheme (MPLADS). Under the scheme, each MP has the choice to suggest to the District Collector for works to the tune of Rs.5 Crores per annum to be taken up in his/her constituency. The Rajya Sabha Members of Parliament can recommend works in one or more districts in the State from where he/she has been elected.

The Nominated Members of the Lok Sabha and Rajya Sabha may select any one or more Districts from any one State in the Country for implementation of their choice of work under the scheme. The Ministry has issued the guidelines on MPLADS Scheme including implementation and monitoring of the scheme. The Department has initiated all necessary steps to ensure that the scheme is successfully implemented in the field.

# Odisha becomes 1st state to extend lockdown till 30 April

**Odisha** has become the first state to extend the **21-day lockdown** till **April 30.** The 21-day nation-wide lockdown will end on April 14. Odisha Chief Minister Naveen Patnaik has requested the Centre not to start train and air services till April 30. The state has also announced that all educational institutions in the state will remain closed **till June 17.** 

**Odisha** is among the states that have made face masks compulsory for people stepping out of their homes. The others are **Delhi, Mumbai, Chandigarh and Nagaland.** 

### IAF airlifts essential drugs to Maldives under 'Operation Sanjeevani'

The Indian Air Force (IAF) has launched 'Operation Sanjeevani' and air-lifted 6.2 tonnes of essential medical supplies to the Maldives via transport aircraft C-130J as assistance in the fight against the COVID 19.

India has supplied 6.2 tonnes of essential medicines to the Maldives as assistance in the fight against The medicines were procured from various cities and delivered by a Hercules aircraft of Indian Air Force. India has also supplied essential food grains and edibles despite logistical challenges in the wake of lockdown. The neighbouring country is mostly dependent on imports from India for such supplies.







Jeff Bezos tops Forbes billionaires list "The Richest in 2020"

Forbes has launched the 34th annual world's billionaires list named as "The Richest in 2020". The list titled "The Richest in 2020" has been topped by the Amazon Founder and Chief Executive Officer Jeff Bezos. This was 3rd time in a row that he has topped the annual world's billionaires list released by Forbes. He has topped the list with a net worth of \$113 billion.

In the 34th annual world's billionaires list named as "The Richest in 2020", Jeff Bezos was followed by Bill Gates having net worth of \$98 billion while luxury goods tycoon Bernard Arnault, the Chairman and CEO of luxury magnate LVMH (LVMHF), stood on the 3rd position with a net worth of \$76 billion.

#### Twitter CEO pledges \$1 billion to combat **COVID-19 pandemic**

Chief Executive Officer of Twitter, Jack Dorsey has pledged to donate **\$1 billion** to charities working towards combatting the global **COVID-19 pandemic.** The donation of \$1 billion by the Twitter CEO seems to be the largest donation pledged by a private individual in the fight against **COVID-19 pandemic**.

To fulfill the donation amount of \$1 billion, Jack Dorsey will move \$1 billion of his digital payments group "Square" equity i.e. 28% of his wealth, to #startsmall LLC to fund global COVID-19 relief.



#### GoI sanctions Rs. 15000 crores package to boost health infrastructure

Government of India (GoI) has announced to allocate Rs. 15000 crores for 'India COVID-19 Emergency Response and Health System Preparedness Package'. The funds sanctioned will be utilized for immediate COVID-19 Emergency Response (amount of Rs.7774 crores) and rest for medium-term support (1-4 years) to be provided under mission mode approach.

#### The key objectives of the package:

- The Package includes mounting emergency response to slow and limit COVID-19 in India through the development of diagnostics and COVID-19 dedicated treatment facilities, centralized procurement of essential medical equipment and drugs required for treatment of infected patients, strengthen and build resilient National and
- State health systems to support prevention and preparedness for future disease outbreaks, setting up of laboratories and bolster surveillance activities, biosecurity preparedness, pandemic research and proactively engage communities and conduct risk communication activities.
- The funds will also help in increasing the production of PPEs (Personal Protection Equipment), ventilators. ICU and other essential equipment.





These interventions and initiatives would be implemented under the overall umbrella of the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare.

#### 'Operation SHIELD' launched in Delhi

**Delhi Government** has launched the '**Operation SHIELD'** to curb the spread of **COVID-19** in the national capital. The Operation SHIELD will be implemented in 21 containment zones as a necessary action to protect the people of Delhi from COVID-19.


S stands for: Sealing of area

The Delhi government has made it mandatory for the people of Delhi to wear masks while stepping out of their houses.

#### **National Affairs**

- **Civil services officers'** associations have formed an initiative called '**Caruna'** to support and supplement the government's efforts in fighting coronavirus. The acronym 'Caruna' stands for Civil Services Associations Reach to Support in Natural Disasters.
- **IIT-Roorkee** has developed a low-cost portable ventilator called **'Prana-Vayu'** in association with **AIIMS-Rishikesh**, which can be manufactured for just **Rs 25,000.** This closed-loop ventilator equipped with state-of-the-art facilities & can prove useful in ensuring the safety of coronavirus (COVID-19) patients.



- The **Ministry of Civil Aviation** has launched the initiative called **"Lifeline UDAN"** to help India fight against COVID-19. Under Lifeline UDAN initiative of Ministry of Civil Aviation, 132 cargo flights have been operated so far across the country to transport medical cargo including to remote and hilly areas.
- The innovation cell of the Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD) and All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) has launched a mega ONLINE challenge **called "SAMADHAN"** to fight against covid19.
- During the 21 days nationwide lockdown due to COVID-19, pharmacists, popularly known as "Swasth ke Sipahi" of Pradhan Mantri Jan Aushadhi Kendra are delivering essential services and medicines at doorstep of patients and elderly.
- The **Ministry of Human Resource Development has designated DigiLocker** as the sole National Academic Depository (NAD). The ministry has directed the **University Grants Commission (UGC)** to implement NAD as a permanent scheme within DigiLocker.
- Amid 21-days nationwide lockdown in India, **Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO)** has been using scientific endeavours to develop products in an accelerated manner to combat COVID-19 pandemic. As a result of its efforts, DRDO has developed **Personnel Sanitisation Enclosures (PSE)** and **Full Face Mask (FFM)** to protect primarily healthcare professionals from novel coronavirus.
- The **Government of India** has launched **an iGOT** elearning platform to combat **COVID-19** for all frontline workers to equip them with the training and updates in coping with Pandemic.
- Tribal Cooperative Marketing Development Federation of India (TRIFED) has collaborated with UNICEF for developing a digital communication strategy for promoting a digital campaign for Self Help Groups (SHGs). The partnership aims to highlight the importance of Social Distancing.

#### **States in the News**

- **'V Safe Tunnel'** has been installed in **Telangana** to sanitize people. The sanitising tunnel has been installed at the state Director General of Police's office. A unique disinfectant named 'V Safe Tunnel' sanitizes people from any possible bacteria and other microbes within 20 seconds.
- The **Chhattisgarh police** developed the app **'Rakhsa Sarv'**, with the help of Noida-based startup **Mobcoder**, which enables them to track the quarantined people through Google Map.





- The government of Telangana invested swiftly to deploy India's first automated "COVID-19 Monitoring System App" by Vera Smart Healthcare.
- Arunachal Pradesh government has launched an app called "COVIDCARE". The newly developed "COVIDCARE" app is an effort of the Arunachal Pradesh government to combat COVID-19.

#### **International Affairs**

- The **United States** has announced **\$2.9 million** aid for India through the **US Agency for International Development (USAID).** The funds announced are going to help India in its fight against COVID-19 and to also provide care for those who are affected and help the local communities with the tools to stop the pandemic spreading in the country.
- The South Asian Association for Regional Cooperation (SAARC) Development Fund (SDF) has allocated \$5 million for COVID-19 related projects in its member states. This project will be funded by the SDF under its Social Window thematic areas. SDF's social window primarily funds projects on poverty alleviation, social development focusing on education, health, and human resource development, among others.
- Asian Development Bank (ADB) assured of \$2.2 billion (about Rs 16,500 crore) support package to India to fight against COVID-19 pandemic. India's needs, including emergency assistance, policy-based loans and budget support to facilitate swift disbursement of ADB funds. ADB stands ready to provide further financial assistance and policy advice whenever the situation warrants.

- Larsen & Toubro(L&T) signs agreement with the Indian Army for setting up an advanced IT-enabled system to operate the Armed Forces network under the Network of Spectrum (NFS).

- Hindustan Unilever has partnered with the United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF) to support India to combat COVID-19. The partnership aims to initiate a mass communication campaign with an objective of informing and empowering the general public against the COVID-19 pandemic.
- Hyderabad-based Indian Immunologicals Limited (IIL) has partnered with Australia's Griffith University to develop the COVID-19 vaccine. Scientists from IIL and Griffith University will jointly develop a "live attenuated SARS – CoV-2 vaccine" or COVID-19 vaccine using the "latest codon deoptimization technology".
- Flipkart Private Limited inks partnership with ICICI Lombard General Insurance Company Limited & Go Digit General Insurance to launched two health insurance policies. The name of the two policies that specifically cover coronavirus (COVID-19) are 'COVID-19 Protection Cover' and 'Digit Illness Group Insurance'.
- **Bharat Biotech** in tie-up with the US-based company **FluGen** and **University of Wisconsin Madison** to develop a vaccine named **"Coro-Flu"** to fight against COVID-19. CoroFlu will build on the backbone of FluGen's flu vaccine candidate known as M2SR.




