No fight is small

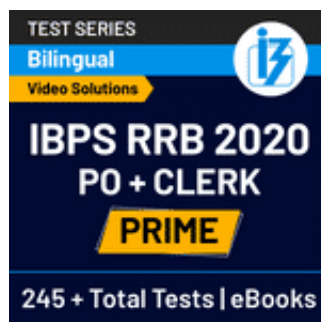
