**Directions (1-5): Study the following information carefully and answer the questions given below:**

Seven persons are sitting in a row facing south. There are three females in the group. Only males sit at the extreme ends of the row. All females sit adjacent to each other. All persons are like three different colours and at least two persons like the same colour. There are three persons between E and G. C is the immediate left of F and immediate right of G. E is the immediate neighbour of A and B. There is only one person between E and F. G likes White with only one person who is not a female. There are two persons between B and G. A likes blue colour only with the person who is at one of the extreme end. D is at the left end of the row. No female is neighbour of A and D. The one who is in the middle of the row has neighbours who like Yellow colour.

Q1. Who among the following person likes blue colour?

Q2. Which of the following is the group of the female member?

**Directions (6-10):** Each of the question below consists of a question and three statements numbered I, II given below it. You have to decide whether the data provided in the statements are sufficient to answer the question.

- (a) If statements I is sufficient to answer the question, but statement II by itself is not sufficient to answer the question.
- (b) If statement II by itself is sufficient to answer the question, but statement I alone is not sufficient to answer the question.
- (c) If statement either I or II is sufficient to answer the question.
- (d) If both the statements I and II taken together are not sufficient to answer the question.
- (e) If both the statements I and II taken together are sufficient to answer the question.

Q6. Who is tallest among five friends P, Q, R, S and T?

I. S is taller than R but just shorter than T.

II. T is shorter than P and Q is shorter than T.

Q7. How is K related to M?

I. M is Q's father's only sister.

II. N is mother of K who is the daughter of O.

Q8. Seven boxes are arranged one above another. Which of the following box is placed at top of the stack?

I. More than two boxes are placed between A and D. Three boxes are placed between E and D, which is placed below box E.

II. Only one box is placed between E and F. Two boxes between G and E. F is not just above Box G.

Q9. How is 'career' written in a code language?

I. 'career manage founder' is written as 'xm nu zx' and 'manage wonder fight' is written as 'zx zy iz' in that code language.

II. 'career iconic founder' is written as 'xm nu zm' in that code language.

Q10. Point P is towards which direction from point Q?

I. Z is in south of Q and west of S, which is in north of M.

II. M is south of S and west of P.

**Q11. Statement:** The 'M' Cooperative Housing Society has put up a notice at its gate that sales persons are not allowed inside the society.

**Assumptions:**

- I. All the sales persons will stay away from the 'M' cooperative Housing Society.
- II. The security guard posted at the gate may be able to stop the sales persons entering the society.

**Q12. Statement:** "If it does not rain throughout this month, most farmers would be in trouble this year."

**Assumptions:**

- I. Timely rain is essential for farming.
- II. Most farmers are generally dependent on rains.

**Q13. Statement:** If the city bus which runs between Ram Nagar and Sant Colony is extended to Vasant Vihar, it will be convenient. — Appeal of residents of Ram Nagar to the city bus company.

**Assumptions:**

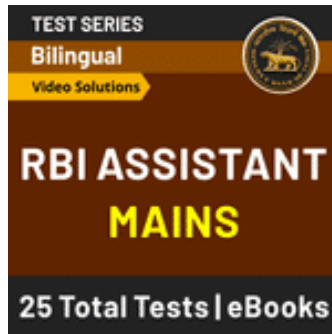
- I. The convenience of the city bus company is much more important than the needs of the consumers.
- II. The city bus company is indifferent to the aspirations of the residents of Sant Colony.

Q14. Which alphabet is 3rd from the left in the meaningful four-letter word formed from the first, fourth, fifth and eighth letter of the word **FOUNDATION**? If more than one word is formed, then mark answer as X and no meaningful word is formed then mark answer as Z.

- (e) D

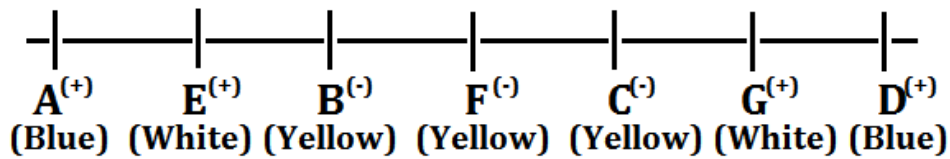

Sol. Using both statements together, P is the tallest person.

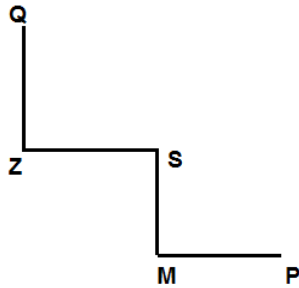

Sol. From both the statements we can find that P is in south-east of Q.

**Solutions (11-13):**

S11. Ans.(e)

Sol. Since both the assumptions follow from the given statement, so both I and II are implicit.

S12. Ans.(e)

Sol. It is mentioned that farmers will be in trouble without rain. This means that timely rain is essential. Also, it shows that farmers are dependent on rain. So, both I and II are implicit.

S13. Ans.(d)

Sol. Clearly, the city bus company is meant to provide bus services according to the needs of the local residents and not as per their own convenience. So, I is not implicit. Again, the statement talks of an appeal of a resident of Ram Nagar. So, nothing can be said about the company's response to appeals of the residents of Sant Colony. So, II is also not implicit.
