# IRDAI allows launch of 'Corona Kavach' insurance policies

General and Health Insurance companies has received approval from the Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority of India (IRDAI) to launch short-term 'Corona Kavach' health insurance policies. The short-term "Corona Kavach" health insurance policy will cover medical expenses occurred due to coronavirus disease.

#### About the Corona Kavach policy:

- IRDAI has designed a standard Covid specific product which addresses the basic health insurance requirements of insuring public containing common policy wordings across the industry.
- The sum insured amount of the policy ranges from Rs 50,000 to Rs 5,00,000.
- Person between the age of 18 to 65 years can avail the benefits of the policy.
- People will be able to avail the Corona Kavach policy for Self, spouse, parents, parents-in-law as well as dependent children up to 25 years of age.

## India ranks 3rd in Global Manufacturing Risk Index 2020

- India is the third top-most country in the Global Manufacturing Risk Index 2020. The annual Global Manufacturing Risk Index (MRI) report was released by the US-based property consultant Cushman & Wakefield, to rank the most suitable locations for global manufacturing among 48 countries in Europe, Americas, and the Asia-Pacific.
- Each of the countries has been assessed in four key areas: Bouncebackability, Conditions, Costs and Risks.
- China and the United States retain the top two positions respectively in MRI 2020, while India has moved one place higher from the previous edition of the report, to rank third in MRI 2020. The MRI 2020 report also includes analysis of the impact of Covid-19 on the global manufacturing sector and the ability of the countries to restart their manufacturing sectors once confinement measures are relaxed and business starts to return to normal.

#### **National News**

- NITI Aayog's Atal Innovation Mission (AIM) has launched "ATL App Development Module" in collaboration with Indian startup Plezmo, for school students nationwide.
- According to the data of the Union Ministry of Commerce, United States was India's top trading partner in fiscal year 2019-20. The bilateral trade between 2 countries has increased from \$87.96 billion in 2018-19 to \$88.75 billion in the fiscal year 2019-20.
- Iran has dropped India from Chabahar rail project which comprises rail line from Chabahar port to Zahedan, along the border with Afghanistan.
- India has handed over outdoor fitness equipment for 61 islands across the Maldives under a cash grant of 8 million US dollars.
- 'Pragyata' guidelines have been released for Digital Education. It include 8 steps of online education that is, Plan, Review, Arrange, Guide, Yak(talk), Assign, Track, and Appreciate.
- Indian Railways has launched a 'Post COVID Coach' to prevent the spread of COVID-19 virus infection. It has been developed by the Indian Railways' production unit, Rail Coach Factory, Kapurthala.
- Railways Minister has announced India's first cablestayed Railways bridge "Anji Khad Bridge" to connect Katra and Reasi in Jammu and Kashmir. It would be developed by Konkan Railway Corporation Limited (KRCL).





- India's first fully indigenously developed Pneumococcal Polysaccharide Conjugate Vaccine (Pneumonia vaccine) has received Drug Controller General of India's (DCGI) approval. It has been developed by Serum Institute of India Pvt Ltd, Pune.
- National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development has launched development projects of worth Rs 44 lakhs in Andaman & Nicobar Islands. Under this, there would be focus on the formation and skill development of Self-Help Groups to promote rural entrepreneurship at micro level.
- Opening session of the Digital Indo-Italian Business Mission on Food Processing was addressed by the Union Minister for Food Processing Industries, Smt. Harsimrat Kaur Badal.
- First on-line NISHTHA programme has been launched for 1200 Key Resources Persons of Andhra Pradesh. It would be conducted through DIKSHA and NISHTHA portals by the National Council of Educational Research and Training (NCERT).
- The fourth edition of the All India Tiger Estimation 2018 has created the Guinness World Record for being the world's largest camera trap wildlife survey.

- The Women Safety Wing, Telangana State Police has launched the "CybHer" campaign in association with the Legal Aid Centre, Symbiosis Law School, Hyderabad to tackle cybercrime against children and women in the state.
- Madhya Pradesh has topped among the other states in the implementation of PM Street Vendor's AtmaNirbhar Nidhi (PM SVANidhi).
- Madhya Pradesh government will commence a unique campaign titled as "Roko-Toko" to target those people who do not wear masks.
- Chhattisgarh government has organised the firste-Lok Adalat of India amid the COVID-19 pandemic.
- Uttarakhand government has decided to convert waste generated in the state to electricity under an initiative titled 'Waste to Energy'.

- Lee Hsien Loong has become the Prime Minister of Singapore after the ruling People's Action Party won the General Elections held in the country.
- India has become the second-largest source of foreign direct investment (FDI) in the United Kingdom. India invested in 120 projects and created 5,429 new jobs in the UK. United States remains the number one source of FDI for the UK.
- Andrzej Duda has been re-elected as the President of Poland.
- China has successfully launched "APSTAR-6D" telecommunication satellite via a Long March 3B carrier rocket from Xichang Satellite Launch Center. It has been developed by China Academy of Space Technology.
- Prime Minister of Tunisia, Elyes Fakhfakh has submitted his resignation.
- Indian-origin, Chandrikapersad 'Chan' Santokhi has been elected the president of South American country "Suriname".
- Pakistan and China have signed an agreement for the 700 MW Azad Pattan hydel power project on the Jhelum river in Sudhoti district of Pakistan Occupied Kashmir (PoK).
- Rose Christiane Ossouka Raponda has been appointed as the first woman prime minister of Gabon. She will succeed Julien Nkoghe Bekale.
