# Union Minister of Agriculture & Farmers' Welfare launches "Krishi Megh"

- Krishi Megh (National Agricultural Research & Education System -Cloud Infrastructure and Services) has been launched. It will help in meeting the services and infrastructure requirements of Digital Agriculture of National Agricultural Research and Education System (NARES).
- The minister also launched the KVC ALUNET (Krishi Vishwavidyalaya Chhatr Alumni Network) and Online Accreditation System for Higher Agricultural Educational Institutions (HEI).
- The National Agricultural Higher Education Project has been funded by the Government of India and the World Bank.

## Jal Shakti Minister launches Swachh Bharat Mission Academy

- The Swachh Bharat Mission Academy has been launched by the Union Minister for Jal Shakti, Shri Gajendra Singh Shekhawat.
- It has been launched as a crucial part of the phase 2 of Swachh Bharat Mission (Grameen).
- It is a phone-based academy and offers a 60-minutes module, which is an IVR based training course, covering a wide range of topics under Open Defecation Free sustainability (ODF-S) as well as Solid and Liquid Waste Management (SLWM).
- It will ensure behaviour change and promote the capacity building of the key stakeholders such as Swachhagrahis, PRIs members, community-based organizations, NGOs, SHGs etc.

# Raksha Mantri launches Naval Innovation and Indigenisation Organisation

- Naval Innovation and Indigenisation Organisation (NIIO) has been launched by the Raksha Mantri Shri Rajnath Singh.
- NIIO is a **three-tiered** organisation and it will enable its end users to interact with academia as well as industry for the promotion of innovation and indigenisation for self-reliance in defence, with the help of its dedicated structures.

- The twin aspects of innovation and indigenisation would be brought together by the Naval Technology Acceleration Council (N-TAC).
- It also includes a working group under the N-TAC, which will be responsible for the implementation of the projects.
- To fulfill the objective of induction of emerging disruptive technology in an accelerated time frame,
   Technology Development Acceleration Cell (TDAC) has been established.

- Line of Credit of worth 18 million US dollars has been extended by the Government of India to the Government of Maldives, with the primary objective of expanding the fishing facilities at Maldives Industrial Fisheries Company (MIFCO).
- Bangladesh has decided to construct a monument for the Indian soldiers who died in 1971 during the Bangladesh's struggle for independence from Pakistan.
- Submarine Optical Fibre Cable (OFC) connecting Andaman & Nicobar Islands to the mainland has been launched. The 2300 Kms long submarine cable will boost the endless opportunities in the Andaman & Nicobar Islands by providing better internet & mobile connectivity.
- National Portal on Human-Elephant conflict called "SURAKHSYA" has been launched to collect real-time information and to manage conflicts on a real-time basis.
- National Infrastructure Pipeline (NIP) Online
   Dashboard has been launched. NIP will act as one
   stop solution for all stakeholders seeking for
   information on infrastructure projects in New India.
- Prime Minister Narendra Modi rolled out the platform for "Transparent Taxation - Honoring the Honest". The new platform will carry forward the journey of direct tax reforms and will also reward the honest taxpayers.
- Indian Railways is observing "Cleanliness Week" from 10th August in order to mark the Independence Day.

- 2nd edition of **Student Entrepreneurship Programme** (SEP 2.0) has been rolled out by the Niti
  Aayog's Atal Innovation Mission (**AIM**) in
  collaboration with **Dell Technologies**. It will enable
  young innovators of Atal Tinkering Labs (ATLs) to
  work closely with Dell volunteers.
- Reliance Foundation has launched the "W-GDP Women Connect Challenge" across India in association with US Agency for International Development (USAID) and Women's Global Development and Prosperity (W-GDP). It aims to bridge the gender divide as well as the digital divide in India.

### **States in the News**

- Khadi and Village Industries Commission (KVIC) will open the Silk Training cum Production Center in the tribal village of Chullyu in Arunachal Pradesh.
- A webinar with title 'AtmaNirbhar Madhya Pradesh: Health and Education' was inaugurated by Union Minister of Education Ramesh Pokhriyal 'Nishank' in New Delhi.
- Mukhya Mantri Kisan Sahay Yojana has been announced by the Gujarat for the current Kharif season and all farmers of the state will be covered under this scheme. Mukhya Mantri Kisan Sahay Yojana will replace the existing crop insurance scheme.
- Chhattisgarh Government has launched the "Indira Van Mitan" Yojana to make the forest dwellers of the state self reliant. Under this, government will form groups of youth in 10,000 villages of tribal areas and they will be responsible to conduct all forest based economic activities.
- Assam government would provide Rs 830 per month each to 17 lakh poor families under the ambitious "Orunodoi" scheme, to financially empower women. It will help poor households to meet their medical, nutritional, and academic needs besides to meet the additional spending during various festivals.
- Price Monitoring and Resource Unit (PMRU) has been established in Karnataka by National Pharmaceutical Pricing Authority (NPPA), Department of Pharmaceuticals, Ministry of Chemicals and Fertilizers, Government of India, in association with Karnataka State Drug Control Department.



## **International Affairs**

- A "state of environmental emergency" has been declared by the island nation of Mauritius, as a Japanese bulk carrier "MV Wakashio" ran aground on a reef in Mauritius and began leaking oil into the ocean.
- Sri Lanka's former President, Mahinda Rajapaksa took oath as the country's Prime Minister for the fourth time.
- President of Belarus, Alexander Lukashenko has won his sixth consecutive term in the country's presidential election.
- Mohamed Ould Bilal has been appointed as the new Prime Minister of Mauritania. The appointment was made following the resignation of his predecessor Ismail Ould Cheikh Sidiya and his entire government.
- Walter Roger Martos Ruiz has become the new Prime Minister of Peru.
- **Russia** has become the **first country** to register a coronavirus vaccine "**Sputnik V**" registered for use.
- Prime Minister of Lebanon, Hassan Diab and his entire government has resigned, in the wake of the major blast in Beirut.

- Boston Group has signed an MoU with the Andhra Pradesh government to set up an IT company in Visakhapatnam.
- Flipkart has signed an MoU with One District, One Product (ODOP) scheme of the Government of Uttar Pradesh. It will bring the artisans, weavers and craftsmen under the ODOP scheme into the scope of the "Flipkart Samarth" initiative.

- Reserve Bank of India has introduced a mechanism of 'Positive Pay' feature for all cheques of value Rs 50,000 and above. This feature helps to avert cheque frauds. The limit of Rs 50,000 will cover approximately 20% of transactions by volume and 80% by value.
- Life Insurance Corporation of India (LIC) has announced a special scheme 'Special Revival Campaign' to revive lapsed policies.
- Paytm has launched India's 1st Pocket Android POS (Point of Sale) Device named 'Paytm All-in-One Portable Android Smart POS' for contactless

- ordering and payments in India. It is an effort to digitise and empower a large number of Small and Medium Enterprises (SMEs).
- Bombay Stock Exchange (BSE) has signed an MoU with Akola, Maharashtra-based bullion trade and industry associations namely Akola Sarafa Association and Akola Sarafa Va Suvarnakar Yuva Sangh, to enhance cooperation between BSE and physical markets represented by the two trade bodies in various areas like knowledge sharing, education and training, events as well as explore areas of mutual interests.
- The proposed combination filed by Keihin Corporation, Nissin Kogyo Co., Ltd., Showa Corporation and Hitachi Automotive Systems, Ltd has received the approval from the Competition Commission of India. The two companies have filed for the formation of a Joint Venture between Honda Motor Co. Limited (HAMCL) and Hitachi Limited (HL).
