Ministry of Culture announces 7 new circles of ASI

- The Union Minister of State for Culture and Tourism (IC), Shri Prahlad Singh Patel has announced 7 new circles of Archaeological Survey of India.
- These new circles have been formed in Madhya Pradesh, Tamil Nadu, Uttar Pradesh, Karnataka, West Bengal and Gujarat.
- Along with the 7 new circles, the minister also added that the Hampi Mini Circle in Karnataka has been converted into a full fledged circle.

NITI Aayog releases report on Export Preparedness Index (EPI) 2020

- NITI Aayog has released the report on Export
 Preparedness Index (EPI) 2020 in
 partnership with the Institute of
 Competitiveness.
- **Gujarat, Maharashtra** and **Tamil Nadu** occupied the **top three ranks** in the Export Preparedness Index (EPI) 2020.
- It evaluates the export preparedness and performance of Indian states.
- It identifies the challenges and opportunities; improve the effectiveness of government policies; and promote a facilitative regulatory framework. Gujarat, Maharashtra and Tamil Nadu occupied the top three ranks in the Export Preparedness Index (EPI) 2020.

The structure of Export Preparedness Index (EPI) 2020 comprises of **4 pillars**:

- Policy
- Business Ecosystem
- Export Ecosystem
- Export Performance

According to the report, **India faces** the following **three fundamental challenges** in the export promotion:

- i) intra- and inter-regional disparities in export infrastructure
- ii) poor trade support and growth orientation among states
- iii) poor R&D infrastructure to promote complex and unique exports.

National News

- Union Minister for road transport and highways, Nitin Gadkari has launched a mobile app named 'Harit Path' to monitor plantation along national highways.
- An online system of Registration and Renewal of Jewellers has been launched along with the online system of recognition and renewal of the Assaying and Hallmarking Centres. These systems are expected to bring about ease of doing business for the jewellers as well as the entrepreneurs. Hallmarking of precious metals will become mandatory from 1st June 2021.
- "Tribes India Showroom" has been einaugurated in Indian Globe Chambers of LIC Western Zonal Office, Fort, Mumbai. It is an initiative of TRIFED, Ministry of Tribal Affairs to promote the livelihood of the tribal people marketing.
- TRIFED has launched the "Tribes India on Wheels", a van which brings various kinds of immunity boosting products like wild honey, organic haldi, amla, ginger, black pepper etc. It will boost the sales and enhance tribal income in these challenging times.



- The longest river ropeway of India has been inaugurated in Assam. It is 1.8 Km long and connects Guwahati and North Guwahati over Brahmaputra river.
- Union Minister of Commerce and Industry, Shri Piyush Goyal has virtually launched the "National GIS-enabled Land Bank system".
- "Chunauti", a Next Generation Startup Challenge Contest has been launched to further boost startups and software products with special attention on Tier-II towns of India.
- Government of India, the Government of Maharashtra, Mumbai Railway Vikas Corporation and the Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank (AIIB) has signed a loan agreement for a \$500 million Mumbai Urban Transport Project-III.
- Department of Pension & Pensioners'
 Welfare has decided to integrate the
 electronic Pension Payment Order (e-PPO)
 with Digi Locker.

- WWF-India Kerala State Office is joining hands with the Society for Odonate Studies (SOS) and Thumbipuranam for the first-ever state "Dragonfly Festival" in Kerala, christened 'Thumbimahotsavam 2020'.
- Uttar Pradesh government has launched the NRI unified portal. It will enable Overseas Indians and NRIs to get their issues resolved with the help of this portal in cooperation with local administration or the State Government.
- Chief Minister of Kerala, Pinarayi Vijayan has commissioned the first-ever marine ambulance named 'PRATHEEKSHA' at Vizhinjam village of Thiruvananthapuram district in Kerala.

International Affairs

- The Africa Regional Certification Commission (ARCC), an independent body set up by the World Health Organization (WHO), has certified the African continent free from wild Polio virus.
- China has successfully launched 5th Earth observation satellite, Gaofen-9 (05), from the Jiuquan Satellite Launch Center in northwest China.
- **Prime Minister** of **Japan**, **Shinzo Abe** has announced to **step down** from the post on 28 August 2020, because of the poor health conditions.


