RBI defers Basel III provisions amid Covid Uncertainty

- The **Reserve Bank of India (RBI)** has deferred implementation of provisions made under **Basel III** capital due to uncertainty related to **COVID crisis**.
- In this regard, RBI will repel the final tranche of the capital conservation buffer (CCB) and the implementation of net stable funding ratio (NSFR) by six months i.e. April 1, 2021.

RBI increased the timeline for additional market borrowing provided to states/UTs by 6 months

- In April 2020, RBI increased the **Ways and Means Advances (WMA)** Limits and overdraft (OD) regulations for states and Union Territories (UTs) to provide additional flexibility for dealing with the Covid-19 crisis until September 30, 2020.
- The Reserve Bank of India has set the limits for Ways and Means Advances (WMA) for the second half of the financial year 2020-21 (October 2020 to March 2021) for Central Government at Rs. 1,25,000 crore.
- The Reserve Bank will trigger fresh floatation of market loans when the Government of India utilizes 75% of the WMA limit.
- Now to further aid the state governments from financial problems, RBI extended this timeline by six months i.e. till March 31, 2021.
- Notably, RBI decided to increase the number of days for which a state/ UT can be in overdraft continuously to **21 working days from 14**.
- Also, the number of days for which a state/ UT can be in overdraft in a quarter was increased to 50 working days from 36.

RBI extends enhanced borrowing limit for banks under MSF till Mar 31, 2021

- RBI also extended the enhanced borrowing facility provided to banks under the **Marginal Standing Facility (MSF)** scheme by six months till March 31, 2021.
- It was initially available up to June 30, 2020, and was later extended up to September 30, 2020, due to economic disruptions amid COVID-19.
- On March 27, this borrowing limit for scheduled banks was increased from **2% to 3%** of their Net Demand and Time Liabilities (NDTL).



National News

- Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority of India (IRDAI) has identified Life Insurance Corporation of India (LIC), General Insurance Corporation of India (GIC) and New India Assurance as domestic systemically important insurers (D-SIIs).
- India has entered into a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with Denmark in the field of Intellectual Property (IP) Cooperation.
- Union Home Minister Shri Amit Shah has inaugurated the "Destination North East-2020" festival. The festival will be held with the theme of "The Emerging Delightful Destinations".
- Dr Harsh Vardhan has launched the ICMR's vaccine web portal and National Clinical Registry for Covid-19. This vaccine web portal will provide information related to the COVID-19 vaccine development in India and abroad. ICMR's Mobile Stroke Unit was also launched. The Mobile Stroke Unit will ensure timely and appropriate treatment to people suffering from heart disease and hypertension.
- National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development will begin a Sanitation Literacy Campaign (SLC) in Karnataka to promote literacy on 'WASH' (Water, Sanitation and Hygiene) in 2,000 villages covering one lakh rural population.
- Union Minister for Social Justice and Empowerment Shri Thaawarchand Gehlot e-launched the "Ambedkar Social Innovation and Incubation Mission (ASIIM)" under the Venture Capital Fund for Scheduled Castes (SCs) to promote innovation and enterprise among SC students studying in higher educational institutions.

- Asian Development Bank (ADB) has approved a 300 million dollar loan to finance inclusive water supply and sanitation infrastructure and services in secondary towns of Rajasthan.
- Union Minister for Chemicals & Fertilizers Shri. D.V.
 Sadananda Gowda has launched POS 3.1 software, SMS Gateway and Home Delivery facility of Fertilizers (RBK) for farmers in Andhra Pradesh.
- Gujarat Government has signed a 5-year Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with Denmark in the water sector. The state government arm Gujarat Water Supply and Sewerage Board has signed the MoU with 'Danish Water Forum' through an online interactive platform.
- Chief Minister of Assam has launched a portal "Kritagyata", an online pension submission and tracking system. It has been launched to lend convenience to the pensioners to dispose off their pension related claims.

- The Prime Minister-designate of **Lebanon**, **Mustapha Adib** has announced his resignation following his failure to form a new cabinet.
- The interim President of Mali, Bah Ndaw, has named former Malian Foreign Minister **Moctar Ouane** as the new prime minister of Mali.

- **Reserve Bank of India** has announced that it will launch "**Positive Pay System**" for **Cheque Truncation System** from **01st January, 2021.** It will be **developed** by the National Payments Corporation of India (**NPCI**). Banks will be required to enable the system for all account holders issuing cheques for amounts of **Rs 50,000 and above.**
- **SBI Card** has launched its new brand campaign titled '**Contactless Connections**', which aims to spreads the message that love and care can be shared even during this difficult period where social distancing is the norm.
- Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has granted in-principle approval to Vakrangee Ltd to set up Bharat Bill Payment Operating Unit (BBPOU) to handle payment services related to bills. It will operate BBPOU under the Payment and Settlement Systems Act, 2007.
- Industrial Development Bank of India (IDBI) become the first to implement the new feature of document embedding facility with Letter of Credit (LC) / Bank Guarantee (BG) messages over SFMS (Structured Financial Messaging System) platform
 of Indian Financial Technology and Allied Services (IFTAS).
- Indian Bank has launched a green initiative named "IB-eNote" to enable a total paperless working environment. This tool enables processing and tracking of notes put up by various offices digitally. The Bank also launched 'Ind Guru', an e-learning platform for its employees.
- Flipkart and Bajaj Allianz General Insurance have launched a cyber insurance cover for online financial frauds. The product, 'Digital Suraksha Group Insurance', will help customers who want to cover themselves against financial losses caused as a result of cyber attacks, cyber frauds, or other such malicious activities across various online platforms.
- National Council of Applied Economic Research (NCAER) has projected the GDP growth for the Indian economy at -12.6% for 2020-21 (FY21).
- Rating agency **ICRA** has revised its forecast for the contraction in India's FY21 GDP to **11%**.
