## S1. Ans.(d)

Sol. The license of Maharashtra-based Shivam Sahakari Bank has been canceled by the RBI as it does not have adequate capital and earning prospects. With the cancellation of the license the process of paying the depositors as per the DICGC Act, 1961 will be set in motion.

### S2. Ans.(e)
