Sol. United Nations observes 30 July every year as World Day Against Trafficking in Persons. In 2013, the General Assembly designated July 30 as the World Day against Trafficking in Persons to raise awareness of the situation of victims of human trafficking and for the promotion and protection of their rights.

Sol. A consignment of 'Raja Mircha', also referred to as King Chilli or Bhoot Jolokia, from Nagaland, has been exported to London for the first time.
