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## NOTIFICATION

### Recruitment of Assistant Professors in Government First Grade Colleges in the State of Karnataka - Including Residual Parent Cadre and Kalyana Karnataka (Local) Posts

Government by its Notification No. ED 257 DCE 2019 (Part-3), Bangalore dated 15-07-2021, have notified Karnataka Examinations Authority as the Selection Authority to conduct Competitive Examination for recruitment to the posts of Assistant Professors in Government First Grade Colleges in the State of Karnataka. Accordingly applications are invited from the eligible candidates as per the provisions laid down in "Karnataka Education Department Services (Collegiate Education Department) (Recruitment of Assistant Professor) (Special) Rules, 2020" and corrigendum notification No. ED 257 DCE 2019 (Part-3) dated 19-10-2020. Applicants have to appear for the Competitive Examination to be conducted by the Karnataka Examinations Authority.

- 1. Assistant Professor Recruitment will be conducted for the following subjects;**  
Kannada, English, Hindi, Urdu, History, Economics, Political Science, Sociology, Education, Law, Social Work, Geography, Geology, Commerce, Management, Physics, Chemistry, Bio-Chemistry, Mathematics, Microbiology, Zoology, Botany, Electronics, Computer Science, Statistics and Fashion Technology.
- 2. Pay Scale:** UGC Pay Scale - Rs. 57700- Rs. 182400
- 3. Pension:** As per Government order No. FD SPL 04 PET 2005 dated 31-03-2006
- 4. Age Limit:** The candidates must have attained the age of 22 years and not have attained the age of -  
a. 45 years in case of candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes and Category-1 of other Backward Classes;  
b. 43 years in case of candidates belonging to Category-II(a), II(b), III(a) and III(b) of other Backward Classes; and  
c. 40 years in case of General Merit Candidates.  
Provided that the maximum age limit prescribed above shall be enhanced by five years to (In-service, NCC Instructor, Village Group Inspector, Bonded Labourer, Census and Widow) those categories, except for persons with bench mark disability eligible for age enhancement as in sub-rule (3) of rule 6 of the Karnataka Civil Services (General Recruitment) Rules, 1977. In case of Persons with bench mark disability, the maximum age limit prescribed above shall be enhanced by ten years, in case of candidates who are ex-servicemen the maximum age limit prescribed above shall be enhanced by three years plus the number of years of service rendered by him in the Armed Forces of the Union; as on the last date fixed for receipt of application.

**5. Method of Applying:**  
Candidates have to apply only through online by browsing the URL: "Assistant Professor Recruitment - 2021" in the KEA Website <http://kea.kar.nic.in>. There is no pen and paper method of applying.

The payment has to be made in the "Computerized Post Office" branches only. Fee relaxation will be given to persons with bench mark disability of more than 40% and those who are holding a disability certificate issued by District Health Officer.

If the candidates desire to apply for more than one post, then they have to apply in the same application, but they have to pay the fees for each post.

#### 8. Educational Qualification:

A. A Master's degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) in a concerned or relevant or allied subject from an Indian University or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign University, (50% in case of candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste or Scheduled Tribes or Other Backward Classes (OBC) (Non-creamy layer) or persons with Bench mark Disability as defined in the Right of persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 (Central Act 49 of 2016) for the purpose of eligibility).

Those who have obtained Degree / Masters Degree from the accredited foreign University, must obtain equivalency degree certificate by submitting an application to Association of Indian Universities Website <https://www.aiu.ac.in> and then apply for the post of recruitment of Assistant Professor.

Relaxation of five percent will be given (from fifty five percent to fifty percent of the marks) to the Ph.D. Degree holders, who have obtained their Masters Degree prior to 19th September, 1991.

#### NOTE:

- The eligibility marks of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible, based on only the qualifying marks without including any grace mark procedures.
- A relevant grade which is regarded as equivalent of fifty five percent, wherever the grading system is followed by a university, established by Law at the Master's level shall also be considered valid.

and

B. been declared successful in the "National Eligibility Test" conducted by UGC or CSIR or similar test accredited by UGC like "State Level Eligibility Test" or "KSET".

C. The candidates, who have been awarded Ph. D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil. or Ph.D. Degree) Regulation, 2009 or University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil or Ph.D. Degree) Regulation, 2016 and their subsequent amendments from time to time as the case may be, shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET or SLET or KSET. Provided that, the award of degree to candidates registered for the M.Phil or Ph.D Programme prior to 11th July 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances or Bye laws or Regulations of the institutions awarding the degree and such Ph.D candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET or SLET or KSET subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions:

- The Ph.D degree of the candidate has been awarded in a regular mode;
- The Ph.D. Thesis has been awarded by atleast two external examiners;
- An open Ph.D viva voce of the candidate had been conducted;
- Candidate has published two research papers from his Ph.D work out of which at least one must be in a refereed journal;
- Candidate has presented at least two papers, based on his Ph.D work in conferences or seminars sponsored or funded or supported by the UGC or ICSSR or CSIR or any similar agency;

The fulfilment of the above conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or Dean (Academic Affairs) of the University concerned and to be obtained as on last date prescribed for applying online and to be submitted at the time of verification of documents.

D. If the Ph.D degree has been obtained from foreign University or institution ranked among top 500 in the World University Ranking (at any time) by any one of the following:-

- Quacquarelli Symonds (QS)
- the times Higher Education (THE) or
- the Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU) of the Shanghai Jiao Tong University (Shanghai);

shall be exempted from the requirement of NET or SLET or KSET.

#### NOTE:

- NET or SLET or KSET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET or SLET or KSET is not conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET or KSET.
- Education qualifications prescribed by the University Grants Commission (UGC) in regulations or guidelines issued from time to time shall be applicable in so far as the post of Assistant Professor.

#### 9. Competitive Examination details:

Competitive Examination will be conducted in Bangalore, Mysore, Shimoga, Dharwad, Belagavi, Kalaburgi and Mangalore. Candidates have to download the admission tickets from the KEA Website when notified and admission tickets will not be sent to individual candidates. The Competitive Examination is likely to be conducted during 3rd or 4th week of December 2021. The Examination Time Table will be notified later in the KEA Website <http://kea.kar.nic.in>. The dates for Competitive Examination will be announced on the KEA Website in due course.

- In case of any discrepancy / ambiguity with regard to any of the above prescribed rules / procedures, Karnataka Civil Services (General Recruitment) Rules, 1977 and its amendment rules shall prevail.
