Embezzlement (noun) 1.

Meaning; The fraudulent conversion of property from a property owner.



Synonyms: fraud, theft Antonyms: honest, return

Tranquility (noun) 2.

Meaning; the state of being tranquil, the absence of disturbance; peacefulness



Synonyms: calmness **Antonyms:** chaos

3. Vanquish (verb)

Meaning; To defeat, to overcome



Synonyms: defeat, conquer **Antonyms:** surrender, lose

4. **Encrust (verb)**

Meaning; To cover with a hard crust.



Synonyms: cover, hide Antonyms: reveal, strip

Bungler (noun) **5.**

Meaning; Someone who makes mistakes because of incompetence.



Synonyms: inept Antonyms: expert

Spook (verb) 6.

Meaning; To frighten



Synonyms: terrify, horrify Antonyms: calm, please

7. Supine (adjective)

Meaning; Reluctant to take action due to indifference



Synonyms: inactive Antonyms: proactive
