1. **Hone (verb)**

**Meaning;** To make more acute, intense, or effective.



**Synonyms:** sharpen, edge

**Antonyms:** blunt, diminish

2. **Tinker (verb)**

**Meaning;** To tinker with; to tweak or attempt to fix.



**Synonyms:** fix, improve

**Antonyms:** destroy, mess

3. **Stark (adjective)**

**Meaning;** Hard, firm; obdurate.



**Synonyms:** evident, absolute

**Antonyms:** indistinct, loose

4. **Docile (adjective)**

**Meaning;** Ready to accept instruction or direction; obedient



**Synonyms:** gentle, subservient

**Antonyms:** harsh, ignorant

5. **Hoodwink (verb)**

**Meaning;** To deceive by disguise



**Synonyms:** mislead, deceive

**Antonyms:** guide, protect

6. **Nonpareil (Adjective)**

**Meaning;** Unequaled, unrivalled



**Synonyms:** Inimitable, incomparable

**Antonyms:** ordinary, comparable

7. **Dawdle (verb)**

**Meaning;** To spend (time) without haste or purpose.



**Synonyms:** delay, linger

**Antonyms:** expedite, hasten
