

VOCABULARY

1. **Culmination (noun)**

Meaning; Attainment or arrival at the highest pitch of glory, power, etc.



Synonyms: bottom, base

Antonyms: highest, peak

2. **Decry (verb)**

Meaning; To denounce as harmful.



Synonyms: condemn, criticise

Antonyms: praise, applaud

3. **Clinch (verb)**

Meaning; To make certain; to finalize.



Synonyms: finalize, conclude

Antonyms: unsettle, release

4. **Sway (verb)**

Meaning; To move or swing from side to side; or backward and forward;



Synonyms: swing

Antonyms: steady

5. **Hazy (adjective)**

Meaning; Not clear or transparent.



Synonyms: unclear, foggy

Antonyms: clear, sunny

6. **Slugfest (verb)**

Meaning; A game or match in which heavy hits are exchanged



Synonyms: spoil

Antonyms: leave

7. **Pell-Mell (Adverb)**

Meaning; disorderly manner



Synonyms: disorganised

Antonyms: organised
