Culmination (noun) 1.

Meaning; Attainment or arrival at the highest pitch of glory, power, etc.



Synonyms: bottom, base Antonyms: highest, peak

2. Decry (verb)

Meaning; To denounce as harmful.



Synonyms: condemn, criticise Antonyms: praise, applaud

Clinch (verb) 3.

Meaning; To make certain; to finalize.



Synonyms: finalize, conclude Antonyms: unsettle, release

Sway (verb) 4.

Meaning; To move or swing from side to side; or backward and forward;



Synonyms: swing **Antonyms**;: steady

Hazy (adjective) **5.**

Meaning; Not clear or transparent.



Synonyms: unclear, foggy Antonyms: clear, sunny

6. Slugfest (verb)

Meaning; A game or match in which heavy hits are exchanged



Synonyms: spoil Antonyms: leave

7. Pell-Mell (Adverb)

Meaning; disorderly manner



Synonyms: disorganised Antonyms: organised
