

VOCABULARY

1. **Vexatious (Adjective)**

Meaning; Causing vexation or annoyance; teasing; troublesome.



Synonyms: irksome, annoying Antonyms: pleasing, aiding

Formidable (adjective) 2.

Meaning: Causing fear, Difficult to defeat



Antonyms; weak, comforting Synonyms; terrible, daunting

3. Fraught (adjective)

Meaning; Distressed or causing distress



Synonyms: worried, distressed

Antonyms: calm, quiet

4. Reckon (verb)

Meaning; To count; to enumerate; to number; also, to compute; to calculate.



Synonyms: estimate, consider Antonyms: refuse, avoid

5. Shrug (noun)

Meaning; To raise (the shoulders) to express uncertainty, lack of concern.



Synonyms: disregard Antonyms: agree

6. Rubric (noun)

Meaning; An established rule or custom; a guideline



Synonyms: course **Antonyms**: disperse

7. Deplore (verb)

Meaning; To bewail; to weep bitterly over; to feel sorrow for.



Synonyms: lament, complain **Antonyms**: commend, compliment
