1. Spite (noun)

Meaning; Ill will or hatred toward another



Synonyms: animosity, hate **Antonyms**: kindness, love

2. Truncate (verb)

Meaning; To shorten (something) by, or as if by, cutting part of it off.



Synonyms: cut, trim Antonyms: stretch, extend

3. Jest (verb)

Meaning; To tell a joke; to talk in a playful manner



Synonyms: mock, tease **Antonyms**: compliment, commend

4. Enthuse (verb) Meaning; to show enthusiasm



Synonyms: motivated, excited **Antonyms**: demotivated, depressed

Misprision (noun)
Meaning; Criminal neglect of duty or wrongful execution of official duties



Synonyms: contempt Antonyms: tolerance

6. Vague (adjective) Meaning; Not clearly expressed



Synonyms: Blur, faint Antonyms: certain, definit

7. Meed (noun)

Synonyms: compensation Antonyms: penalty
