## 1. Wily (adjective)

Meaning; sly, cunning, full of tricks



Synonyms: clever, canny Antonyms: ignorant, naive

#### Gnaw (verb) 2.

Meaning; To produce excessive anxiety or worry.



Synonyms: torture, trouble

Antonyms: soothe, aid

### Disenchantment (noun) 3.

Meaning; Disillusionment



Synonyms: Dissatisfaction, Discontent

Antonyms: content, pleased

#### Ablution (noun) 4.

Meaning; The act of washing or cleansing the body



Synonyms: clean Antonyms: pollution

### Corpus (noun) 5.

Meaning; A collection of writings, a body, a collection.



Synonyms: compilation, collection

Antonyms: sole, individual

## Smidgen (noun) 6.

Meaning; A very small quantity or amount.



Synonyms: bit Antonyms: lot

## 7. Perfunctory (adjective)

Meaning; Done only to fulfil a duty, or in a careless or indifferent manner



Synonyms: careless Antonyms: careful
