

VOCABULARY

1. **Reprobate (noun)**

Meaning; An individual with low morals or principles



Synonyms: Villian, Wretch

Antonyms: virtuous, righteous

2. **Gaze (verb)**

Meaning; To stare intently or earnestly.

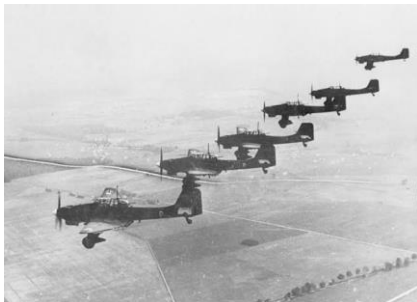


Synonyms: stare, observe

Antonyms: ignore, neglect

3. **Blitzkrieg (noun)**

Meaning; A fast, sudden military offensive, usually combining ground forces with air support.



Synonyms: bombardment, flurry

Antonyms: protection, defence

4. **Fret (verb)**
Meaning; To chafe or irritate; to worry.



Synonyms: concern, discomfort
Antonyms: relax, comfort

5. **Gnaw (verb)**
Meaning; To produce excessive anxiety or worry.



Synonyms: torture, trouble
Antonyms: soothe, aid

6. **Peevish (adjective)**
Meaning; Easily annoyed, especially by things that are not important; irritable,



Synonyms: irritable
Antonyms: affable

7. **Evangelize (verb)**
Meaning; To preach any ideology to those who have not yet been converted to it.



Synonyms: preach
Antonyms: dissuade
