

VOCABULARY

1. **Trove (noun)**

Meaning; A treasure trove; a collection of treasure.



Synonyms: reservoir, stock

Antonyms: litter, junk

2. **Humdrum (adjective)**

Meaning; Lacking variety or excitement; dull; boring.



Synonyms: boring

Antonyms: exciting

3. **Exonerate (verb)**

Meaning; To relieve (someone or something) of a load; to unburden (a load).



Synonyms: absolve, acquit

Antonyms: charge, convict

4. **Splinter (verb)**

Meaning; To break, or cause to break, into factions.



Synonyms: split, fracture

Antonyms: join, combine

5. **Subterranean (adjective)**

Meaning; below ground, under the earth, underground



Synonyms: subversive, covert

Antonyms: open, palpable

6. **Blatant (Adjective)**

Meaning; Bellowing; disagreeably clamorous; sounding loudly and harshly.



Synonyms: glaring

Antonyms: subtle

7. **Staid (adjective)**

Meaning; Not capricious or impulsive; sedate, serious, sober.



Synonyms: composed

Antonyms: frivolous
