1. **Adroit (adjective)**

Meaning; Deft, dexterous, or skillful



Synonyms: skilful, agile

Antonyms: incompetent, unskilled

2. **Scalding (adjective)**

Meaning; An instance of scalding: a burn

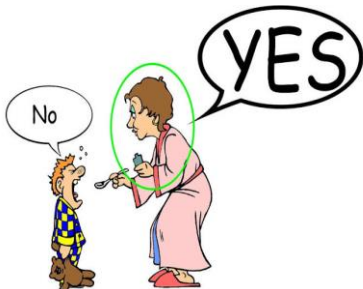


Synonyms: blazing

Antonyms: cool

3. **Foist (verb)**

Meaning; To force another to accept especially by stealth or deceit.



Synonyms: force, inflict

Antonyms: remove, prevent

4. **Slate (verb)**
Meaning; To criticise harshly.



Synonyms: lambaste, attack
Antonyms: praise, applaud

5. **Veer (verb)**
Meaning; To change direction or course suddenly; to swerve



Synonyms: sheer, drive
Antonyms: stable, static

6. **Conundrum (noun)**
Meaning; A difficult question or riddle



Synonyms: dilemma, difficulty
Antonyms: solution, clarity

7. **Unnerving (Adjective)**
Meaning; To make somebody nervous, upset



Synonyms: disturbing, Discomforting
Antonyms: Pleasing, Comforting
