Muster (verb) 1.

Meaning; Gathering



Synonyms: gather, collect Antonyms: disperse, spread

2. Strife (verb)

Meaning; Bitter conflict, sometimes violent.



Synonyms: clash, controversy

Antonyms: peace, concord

Clinch (verb) 3.

Meaning; To make certain; to finalize



Synonyms: conclude, settle Antonyms: unsettle, confuse

Boulder (noun) 4.

Meaning; A large mass of stone



Synonyms: stone Antonyms: sand

5. Dodder (verb)

Meaning; To shake or tremble



Synonyms: stagger, stumble **Antonyms**: stay, remain

Ingenuity (adjective) 6.

Meaning; The ability to solve difficult problems, often in original, clever, and inventive ways.



Synonyms: creativity, innovation Antonyms: ordinary, usual

7. Reckon (verb)

Meaning; To count; to enumerate; to number; also, to compute; to calculate.



Synonyms: consider Antonyms: avoid
