

VOCABULARY

1. **Repudiate (verb)**

Meaning; To refuse to have anything to do with; to disown.



Synonyms: abandon, deny

Antonyms: accept, approve

2. **Plaudit (noun)**

Meaning; A mark or expression of applause; praise



Synonyms: commendation, appreciation

Antonyms: condemnation, criticism

3. **Elusive (adjective)**

Meaning; Evading capture, comprehension or remembrance.



Synonyms: evasive, slippery

Antonyms: direct, straight

4. **Augury (noun)**

Meaning; An omen or prediction; a foreboding



Synonyms: sign, warning

Antonyms: ignorance, disregard

5. **Dotard (noun)**

Meaning; An old person with impaired intellect



Synonyms: old, elder

Antonyms: youth, younger

6. **Exacerbate (verb)**

Meaning; To make worse (a problem, bad situation)



Synonyms: worsen, aggravate

Antonyms: pacify, hold

7. **Wrangle (noun)**

Meaning; To bicker, or quarrel



Synonyms: tussle, brawl

Antonyms: peace, harmony
