1. **Fawning (adjective)**

Meaning; Seeking favor by way of flattery; flattering, servile.



Synonyms: subservient, ingratiating

Antonyms: opinionated, imperious

2. **Aghast (adjective)**

Meaning; Terrified; struck with amazement

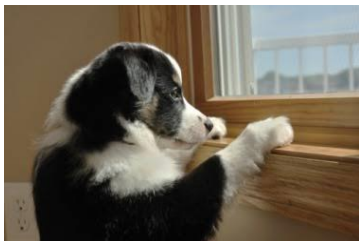


Synonyms: surprised, anxious

Antonyms: unsurprised, calm

3. **Plaintive (adjective)**

Meaning; Sounding sorrowful, mournful



Synonyms: painful, pathetic

Antonyms: joyful, cheerful

4. **Logjam (noun)**

Meaning; A clog or such jam or mess that halts or greatly delays progress.



Synonyms: stagnation, deadlock

Antonyms: advance, expedition

5. **Tweak (verb)**

Meaning; A sharp pinch or jerk; a twist or twitch.



Synonyms: twist, change

Antonyms: hold, grasp

6. **Piquant (adjective)**

Meaning; Favorably stimulating to the palate; pleasantly spicy



Synonyms: stimulating, fascinating

Antonyms: dull, bland

7. **Heft (noun)**

Meaning; Heaviness, the feel of weight



Synonyms: heavy, burdensome

Antonyms: light, floaty
