

VOCABULARY

1. Jeopardize (verb)

Meaning; To put in jeopardy, to threaten.



Synonyms: endanger, risk Antonyms: shelter, protection

2. Dilemma (noun)

Meaning; A difficult circumstance or problem.



Synonyms: Difficulty, predicament Antonyms: clearity, precision

3. Lopsided (adjective)

Meaning; Not even or balanced; not the same on one side as on the other.



Synonyms: unbalanced, irregular Antonyms: balanced, regular

4. **Internment (noun)**

Meaning; Confinement within narrow limits



Synonyms: detain, restrain **Antonyms**: free, liberate

5. Suffuse (verb)

Meaning; To spread through or over something, especially as a liquid, colour or light; to bathe.



Synonyms: spread Antonyms: collect

Doom (noun) 6.

Meaning; An undesirable fate



Synonyms: destruction, catastrophe Antonyms: appreciation, admiration

Burnish (verb) 7.

Meaning; To make smooth or shiny by rubbing; to polish; to shine.



Synonyms: brighten, shine Antonyms: tarnish, dull
