1. Smug (Adjective)

Meaning; Irritatingly pleased with oneself, offensively self-complacent, self-satisfied.



Synonyms: complacency, egotism

Antonyms: bashfulness, shyness

2. Furlough (noun)

Meaning; A leave of absence or vacation



Synonyms: recess, break

Antonyms: recall, travail

3. Wrest (verb)

Meaning; To seize.



Synonyms: snatch, grab

Antonyms: release, give

4. **Pander (verb)**

Meaning; To make illicit or illegal offer



Synonyms: gratify, indulge

Antonyms: refuse, dissatisfy

5. **Woe (noun)**

Meaning; Great sadness or distress



Synonyms: distress, unhappiness

Antonyms: pleasure, happiness

6. **Vicious (adjective)**

Meaning; Violent, destructive and cruel.



Synonyms: cruel, barbarous

Antonyms: civilized, generous

7. **Wraps (verb)**

Meaning; To conceal by enveloping or enfolding; to hide



Synonyms: hide, conceal

Antonyms: reveal, disclose
