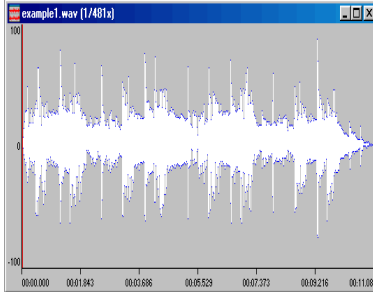


## VOCABULARY

### 1. Distortion (noun)

**Meaning;** Noise or other artifacts caused in the electronic reproduction of sound or music.



**Synonyms:** disruption, interruption

**Antonyms:** clear, perfect

### 2. Aghast (adjective)

**Meaning;** Terrified; struck with amazement



**Synonyms:** surprised, anxious

**Antonyms:** unsurprised, calm

### 3. Embezzlement (noun)

**Meaning;** The fraudulent conversion of property from a property owner.



**Synonyms:** fraud, theft

**Antonyms:** honest, return

4. **Recalcitrant (adjective)**

**Meaning;** Marked by a stubborn unwillingness to obey authority



**Synonyms:** disobedient, rebellious

**Antonyms:** obedient, compliant

5. **Exult (verb)**

**Meaning;** To rejoice



**Synonyms:** cheer, enjoy

**Antonyms:** mourn, grieve

6. **Nimble (adjective)**

**Meaning;** Quick-witted and alert.



**Synonyms:** clever, alert

**Antonyms:** dull, dorky

7. **Breakthrough (noun)**

**Meaning;** Any major progress; such as a great innovation



**Synonyms:** discovery, boost

**Antonyms:** decline, decrease
