### 1. Consternation (noun)

**Meaning;** Amazement or horror that confounds the faculties



**Synonyms:** disquiet, dismay

**Antonyms:** peace, tranquility

### 2. Nab (verb)

**Meaning;** To seize, arrest



**Synonyms:** arrest, seize

**Antonyms:** liberate, free

### 3. Frenetic (adjective)

**Meaning;** Fast, harried; having extreme enthusiasm or energy.



**Synonyms;** hectic, wild

**Antonyms;** tranquil, settled

4. **Dodder (verb)**

**Meaning;** To shake or tremble



**Synonyms:** stagger, stumble

**Antonyms:** stay, remain

5. **Bastion (noun)**

**Meaning;** A well-fortified position; a stronghold or citadel.



**Synonyms:** citadel

**Antonyms:** vulnerable

6. **Obstreperous (adjective)**

**Meaning;** Attended by, or making, a loud and tumultuous noise; boisterous.



**Synonyms:** blustering

**Antonyms:** calm

7. **Bode (verb)**

**meaning;** To indicate by signs, as future events



**Synonyms:** forecast

**Antonyms:** ignore
