### 1. Fidgety (adjective)

**Meaning;** Having, or pertaining to, a tendency to fidget; restless



**Synonyms:** uneasy, restless

**Antonyms:** calm, tranquil

### 2. Whimsical (adjective)

**Meaning;** playful, quirky



**Synonyms:** funny

**Antonyms:** normal

### 3. Shrill (adjective)

**Meaning;** High-pitched and piercing



**Synonyms:** piercing, sharp

**Antonyms:** soft, low

4. **Negate (verb)**

**Meaning;** To nullify



**Synonyms:** disapprove, cancel

**Antonyms:** approve, allow

5. **Smug (Adjective)**

**Meaning;** Irritatingly pleased with oneself, offensively self-complacent, self-satisfied.



**Synonyms:** complacency, egotism

**Antonyms:** bashfulness, shyness

6. **Analogous (noun)**

**Meaning;** bearing some resemblance or proportion



**Synonyms:** alike, similar

**Antonyms:** different, unlike

7. **Spur (verb)**

**Meaning;** Anything that inspires or motivates



**Synonyms:** propel, excite

**Antonyms:** hault, dissuade
