1. Unsavoury (adjective)

Meaning; Of bad taste; distasteful.



Synonyms: unpleasant, disagreeable Antonyms: pleasant, satisfying

Protracted (adjective) 2.

Meaning; Lasting for a long time or longer than expected or usual.



Synonyms: long, endless Antonyms: short, brief

3. Bluster (verb)

Meaning; To speak or protest loudly



Synonyms: boasting, aggressiveness

Antonyms: pacify, calmness

4. **Consternation (noun)**

Meaning; terror, combined with amazement; dismay



Synonyms: anxiety, disturbance Antonyms: satisfaction, comfort

5. **Erstwhile (Adjective)**

Meaning; Formerly; in the past.



Synonyms: former, past

Antonyms: contemporary, ongoing

6. Laud(verb)

Meaning; Praise or glorification



Synonyms: hail, commend Antonyms: criticise, denounce

7. Scrunch (verb)

Meaning; To crumple and squeeze to make more compact.



Synonyms: compress, supress Antonyms: expand, ease
