1. Egregious (adjective)

Meaning; Outrageously bad; shocking

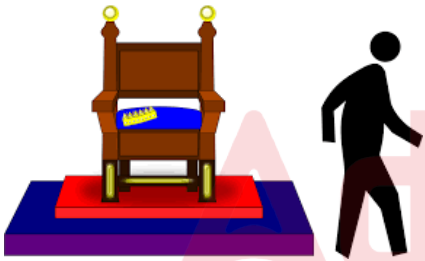


Synonyms: Horrifying, terrible

Antonyms: amazing, marvellous

2. Abdicate (verb)

Meaning; To formally separate oneself from or to divest oneself of.



Synonyms: retire, depose

Antonyms: retain, occupy

3. Robust (adjective)

Meaning; Evincing strength and health; strong



Synonyms: tough, powerful

Antonyms: infirm, weak

4. Outliers (noun)

Meaning; A person or thing situated away from the main body or outside its proper place.



Synonyms: different, unlike

Antonyms: same, alike

5. Myriad (adjective)

Meaning; Great in number; innumerable, multitudinous



Synonyms: infinite, unlimited

Antonyms: restricted, limited

6. Spawn(verb)

Meaning; To generate, bring into being



Synonyms: originate, initiate

Antonyms: finish, complete

7. Parlous (adjective)

Meaning; dangerous; risky.



Synonyms: dreadful, terrible

Antonyms: pleasant, satisfying
