

1. **Lag (verb)**

Meaning; to fail to keep up (the pace), to fall behind



Synonyms; linger, straggle

Antonyms; Usher, lead

2. **Riparian (Adjective)**

Meaning; Of or relating to the bank of a river or stream.



Synonyms: riverside, coastal

Antonyms: inland, continental

3. **Histrionic (noun)**

Meaning; Excessively dramatic or emotional, especially with the intention to draw attention.

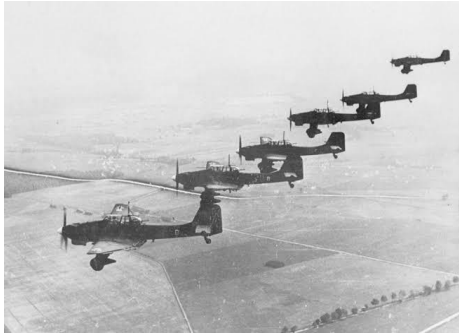


Synonyms: exaggerated, drama

Antonyms: subdued, restrained

4. **Blitzkrieg (noun)**

Meaning; A fast, sudden military offensive, usually combining ground forces with air support.



Synonyms: bombardment, flurry

Antonyms: protection, defence

5. **Stentorian (adjective)**

Meaning; Loud, powerful, booming



Synonyms: clamorous, resounding

Antonyms: soothing, peaceful

6. **Ennui (noun)**

Meaning; A gripping listlessness or melancholia caused by boredom; depression.



Synonyms: boredom

Antonyms: excitement

7. **Entwine (verb)**

Meaning; To twist or twine around something



Synonyms: entangle, twist

Antonyms: unwind, untwist
