1. **HEAVE (verb)**

**Meaning;** To lift with difficulty



**Synonyms:** pull, drag

**Antonyms:** push, hold

2. **THRALL (noun)**

**Meaning;** One who is enslaved or under mind control.



**Synonyms:** slavery

**Antonyms:** mastery

3. **PEEVISH (adjective)**

**Meaning;** Easily annoyed, especially by things that are not important; irritable



**Synonyms:** irritable

**Antonyms:** affable

4. **TROVE (noun)**

**Meaning;** A treasure trove; a collection of treasure.



**Synonyms:** reservoir, stock

**Antonyms:** litter, junk

5. **CHOPPY (adjective)**

**Meaning;** Discontinuous, intermittent



**Synonyms:** turbulent, stormy

**Antonyms:** silent, calm

6. **HUMDRUM (adjective)**

**Meaning;** Lacking variety or excitement; dull; boring.



**Synonyms:** boring

**Antonyms:** exciting

7. **STALD (adjective)**

**Meaning;** Not capricious or impulsive; sedate, serious, sober.



**Synonyms:** composed

**Antonyms:** frivolous
