

VOCABULARY

1. Wrought (adjective)

Meaning; Having been worked or prepared somehow.



Synonyms: fixed, specified **Antonyms**: common, ordinary

2. Clinch (verb)

Meaning; To make certain; to finalize.



Synonyms: finalize, conclude **Antonyms**: unsettle, release

3. Exonerate (verb)

Meaning; To relieve (someone or something) of a load; to unburden (a load).



Synonyms: absolve, acquit **Antonyms**: charge, convict

4. Splinter (verb)

Meaning; To break, or cause to break, into factions.



Synonyms: split, fracture **Antonyms**: join, combine

5. Inflammatory (noun)

Meaning; Tending to inflame or provoke somebody.



Synonyms: provocative **Antonyms**: mitigating

6. Subterranean (adjective)

Meaning; below ground, under the earth, underground



Synonyms: subversive, covert **Antonyms**: open, palpable

7. Blatant (Adjective)

Meaning; Bellowing; disagreeably clamorous; sounding loudly and harshly.



Synonyms: glaring Antonyms: subtle
