Splurge (verb) 1.

Meaning; To spend lavishly or extravagantly, especially money



Synonyms: fling, disburse Antonyms: preserve, hoard

2. Purloin (verb)

Meaning; To take the property of another, often in breach of trust; to appropriate wrongfully; to steal.



Synonyms: steal, loot

Antonyms: donate, contribute

3. Contrition (noun)

Meaning; The state of being contrite; sincere penitence or remorse.



Synonyms: regret, remorse **Antonyms**: remorselessness

4. Environ (verb)

Meaning; To surround; to encircle



Synonyms: surround, encircle

Antonyms: free, liberate

Carnage (noun) 5.

Meaning; Death and destruction.



Synonyms: bloodshed

Antonyms: peace

6. Coherence (noun)

Meaning; The quality of cohering, or being coherent; internal consistency.



Synonyms: consistency, unity

Antonyms: inconsistency, disunity

7. Feeble (adjective)

Meaning; Deficient in physical strength



Synonyms: weak, unwell **Antonyms**: strong, well
