

1. **Apportion (noun)**

**Meaning;** To divide and distribute portions of a whole.



**Synonyms:** divide, distribute

**Antonyms:** withhold, keep

2. **Bout (noun)**

**Meaning;** A period of something, usually painful or unpleasant



**Synonyms:** stretch

**Antonyms:** stagnation

3. **Sabotage (noun)**

**Meaning;** To deliberately destroy or damage something



**Synonyms:** destroy, damage

**Antonyms:** enhance, upgrade

4. **staid (adjective)**

**Meaning;** Not capricious or impulsive; sedate, serious, sober.



**Synonyms:** composed, dignified

**Antonyms:** hilarious, indecorous

5. **Foray (noun)**

**Meaning;** A sudden or irregular incursion in border warfare

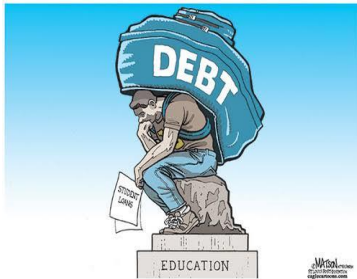


**Synonyms:** invasion

6. **Onerous (adjective)**
