

1. **Rebuff (verb)**

**Meaning;** A sudden resistance or refusal.



**Synonyms:** reject, deny

**Antonyms:** accept, approve

2. **Spiralling (verb)**

**Meaning;** increasing continually.



**Synonyms:** rising, increasing

**Antonyms:** falling, decreasing

3. **Foist (verb)**

**Meaning;** To force another to accept especially by stealth or deceit.



**Synonyms:** Inflict, impose

**Antonyms:** prevent, help

**4. Plaudit (noun)**

**Meaning;** A mark or expression of applause; praise



**Synonyms:** commendation, appreciation

**Antonyms:** condemnation, criticism

**5. Corpus (noun)**

**Meaning;** A collection of writings, a body, a collection.



**Synonyms:** compilation, collection

**Antonyms:** sole, individual

**6. Sack (verb)**

**Meaning;** To discharge from a job or position; to fire.



**Synonyms:** terminate, dismiss

**Antonyms:** recruit, hire

**7. Gullible (adjective)**

**Meaning;** Easily deceived



**Synonyms:** naive
