

1. **Exult (verb)**

**Meaning;** To rejoice



**Synonyms:** cheer, enjoy

**Antonyms:** mourn, grieve

2. **Strident (adjective)**

**Meaning;** Loud; shrill, piercing, high-pitched; rough-sounding



**Synonyms:** harsh, loud

**Antonyms:** soft, melodious

3. **Tandem (adverb)**

**Meaning;** One behind the other.



**Synonyms:** sequential

**Antonyms:** alone

4. **Poised (adjective)**

**Meaning;** Ready, prepared.



**Synonyms:** hover

**Antonyms:** reject

5. **Wanton (adjective)**

**Meaning:** Undisciplined, unruly; not able to be controlled



**Synonyms:** outrageous

**Antonyms:** decent

6. **Fleeting (adjective)**

**Meaning;** Passing quickly; of short duration.



**Synonyms:** brief

**Antonyms:** lasting

7. **Recalcitrant (adjective)**

**Meaning;** Marked by a stubborn unwillingness to obey authority



**Synonyms:** disobedient, rebellious

**Antonyms:** obedient, compliant
