# Solutions

S1. Ans.(c)

Sol. The RBI increased its gold reserves by 4.5% to 794.64 metric tonnes in the fiscal year that ended on March 31, 2023.

S2. Ans.(d)

Sol. The RBI's gold reserves comprised 7.81% of the country's total foreign exchange reserves as of March 31, 2023, up from 7% at the end of the previous fiscal year.

S3. Ans.(b)

Sol. The World Gold Council report stated that Monetary Authority of Singapore was the largest single buyer of gold, adding 69 metric tonnes during January-March 2023.

S4. Ans.(d)

Sol. The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) imposed a monetary penalty of Rs 1.73 crore on the Hongkong and Shanghai Banking Corporation Ltd (HSBC Bank) for violating the Credit Information Companies Rules, 2006.

S5. Ans.(c)

Sol. BharatPe has announced the rebranding of PAYBACK India as Zillion, aligning with the company's vision to make it a ubiquitous loyalty and rewards program across the nation.

# S6. Ans.(c)

Sol. The Global Collections service is an international payment collection service for exporters who hold an account with YES Bank, allowing them to collect payments in over 30 foreign currencies using the service.

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### S7. Ans.(d)

Sol. An e-FIRA is a foreign inward remittances advice that provides exporters with a certificate for the international payments received. With the Global Collections service, exporters can receive an e-FIRA within 24 hours.

### S8. Ans.(c)

Sol. International Monetary Fund. Sri Lanka secured a \$3 billion bailout package from the International Monetary Fund in March to help alleviate its economic crisis. In the midst of an economic crisis, India has decided to extend a \$1 billion credit line to Sri Lanka for another year, providing the much-needed funds to pay for essential imports. The credit line is part of the \$4 billion emergency assistance extended by India to Sri Lanka during its peak crisis time last year.

Sol. The Petersberg Climate Dialogue, a forum for high-level international climate talks held annually before the United Nations Climate Change Conferences (COP), took place in Berlin, Germany from May 2-3, 2023. This year's conference was hosted by Germany and the United Arab Emirates, which is hosting the 28th Conference of Parties (COP28) to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC).
