1. **Foray (noun)**

**Meaning;** A sudden or irregular incursion in border warfare



**Synonyms:** invasion

**Antonyms:** withdrawal

2. **Cozen (verb)**

**Meaning;** To cheat; to defraud



**Synonyms:** cheat, deceive

**Antonyms:** reveal, expose

3. **Vicious (adjective)**

**Meaning;** Violent, destructive and cruel.

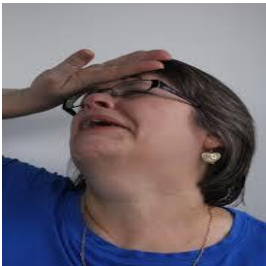


**Synonyms:** cruel, barbarous

**Antonyms:** civilized, generous

4. **Woe (noun)**

**Meaning;** Great sadness or distress

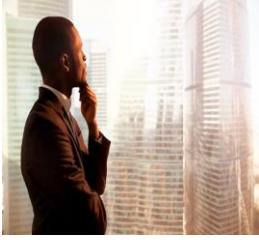


**Synonyms:** distress, unhappiness

**Antonyms:** pleasure, happiness

**5. Envision (verb)**

**Meaning;** To conceive or see something within one's mind. To imagine.



**Synonyms:** envisage, visualise

**Antonyms:** overlook, neglect

**6. Fiery (noun)**

**Meaning;** Tempestuous or emotionally volatile.



**Synonyms:** violent, ignited

**Antonyms:** moderate, passive

**7. Ruse (noun)**

**Meaning;** An action intended to deceive; a trick.



**Synonyms:** hoax, dodge
